3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Whose case is
4	18-251-00169?
5	MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, I have the rest of
6	the calendar.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Have a seat
8	then. Introduce yourself. El Rincon, come
9	forward, please. Introduce yourself for the
10	record.
11	Are you an interpreter, ma'am?
12	INTERPRETER NAVARRO: Yes.
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The
14	attorney is not going to be here before 10:30.
15	MS. SCHMIDT: I was
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: before
17	11:30. And it's my understanding that there is
18	no OICs in this case, so
19	MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, there is. An OIC
20	was reached I was not in the office yesterday
21	and I got an email yesterday the OIC was reached
22	late after in the afternoon yesterday.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
2	Well, hold on, hold on a minute. Introduce
3	yourself for the record, please. I'm sorry,
4	Spanish?
5	INTERPRETER NAVARRO: Mm-hmm.
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Raise your
7	right hand, please.
8	INTERPRETER NAVARRO: Yes.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hold on one
10	minute. Put your hand down until I get it. I
11	try to make sure I read the correct statement.
12	Okay. All right. Hold on, please.
13	Okay. Do you solemnly affirm that you
14	will faithfully and accurately interpret these
15	proceedings in the matter from English to Spanish
16	and from Spanish to English to the best of your
17	ability?
18	INTERPRETER NAVARRO: I swear.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
20	Well, introduce yourself for the record, please.
21	INTERPRETER NAVARRO: I am Magdalena
22	Navarro. I'm a Spanish/English interpreter.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Thank
2	you. You guys can sit. He can introduce
3	himself, too. Have him introduce himself, too,
4	please.
5	MR. SOLLOSO: My name is Manuel
6	Solloso.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
8	Mr. Solloso.
9	MR. SOLLOSO: Solloso.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Solloso.
11	MR. SOLLOSO: S-O double L-O-S-O.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
13	Thank you. Please, sign-in.
14	All right. Okay. All right. So Mr.
15	Solloso?
16	MR. SOLLOSO: Yes, sir.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Your attorney
18	had informed us this morning that she would not
19	be here until 11:30. So that's another hour.
20	And so that's one of the reasons why we are going
21	to move forward. And all we are doing today,
22	since your attorney is not here, is scheduling

this matter for a Show Cause Hearing on April 1 2 10th at 10:00. 3 INTERPRETER NAVARRO: 10:30? 4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 10:00. 5 INTERPRETER NAVARRO: 10:00. I spoke to the attorney 6 MR. SOLLOSO: 7 yesterday and he told me to come here today to say that we accept the settlement offered 8 9 between, you know, the --10 All right. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 11 you want to move forward without your attorney 12 here today to accept the settlement offer? 13 MR. SOLLOSO: Yes. A settlement was 14 reached and I'm happy to just pay and close the 15 case. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 17 right. I just want to make it -- I just want to 18 be clear, okay? Your attorney told us she is 19 going to be here at 11:30. However, because you 20 said that a settlement was reached, you want to 21 move forward now without your attorney. Is that

correct?

1	MR. SOLLOSO: Correct.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I need you to
3	say yes, sir.
4	MR. SOLLOSO: Yes, I agree.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms.
6	Schmidt, are there any preliminary matters in
7	this case?
8	MS. SCHMIDT: Yes. There is an Offer
9	in Compromise consisting of a \$1,500 fine for
10	Charge 1 to be paid within 30 days or the license
11	shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is
12	paid.
13	Charge 2 is to be dismissed.
14	And then Charge 3 is a \$350 fine to be
15	paid within 30 days or else the license will be
16	suspended indefinitely until this fine is paid
17	for a total of \$1,850 within payable within 30
18	days.
19	INTERPRETER NAVARRO: He would like to
20	pay now.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So
22	it's my understanding that there is an Offer in

1	Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that a
2	fine for Charge 1 a \$1,500 fine payable in 30
3	days. Charge 2 will be dismissed. Charge 3,
4	\$350 payable in 30 days. Is this your
5	understanding of you can pay whenever you want
6	to, but yeah, is this your understanding of
7	the Offer in Compromise, sir?
8	MR. SOLLOSO: Yes, I understand.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Are
LO	you also aware that by accepting an Offer in
L1	Compromise, you are giving up your right to a
L2	hearing?
L3	MR. SOLLOSO: Yes, of course.
L4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And you also
L5	understand by giving up your right in you are
L6	giving up your right to appeal this matter? Is
L7	that correct?
L8	MR. SOLLOSO: Yes, I understand,
L9	because the people who are working there are no
20	longer working there.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
22	Thank you. All right.

1	With that said, I then make a motion
2	that the Offer in Compromise for Charge 1 a fine
3	of \$1,500; Charge 2 will be dismissed; Charge 3 a
4	fine of \$350, for a total fine of \$1,850 be
5	payable within 30 days. If the fine is not
6	payable in 30 days, the license will be
7	suspended. Is there a second?
8	MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein
LO	has seconded the motion.
L1	All those in favor say aye.
L2	ALL: Aye.
L3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
L 4	The matter passes 6-0-0.
L5	Thank you. We will have you sign-off
L6	on the paperwork today, sir. You can pay the
L7	fine today or you can pay it in 30 days. Thank
L8	you very much.
L9	MR. SOLLOSO: I have check. I mean,
20	I don't bring the cash in.
21	INTERPRETER NAVARRO: Can he pay by
22	check?

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I don't know
2	how they accept payment at the front desk, so
3	however you have always paid, you go to the front
4	desk, sir, and as long as it's good money, I
5	assume they will take it.
6	Thank you very much, sir.
7	MR. SOLLOSO: Thank you. Also, thank
8	you.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, all right.
10	Thank you. So you have some paperwork to sign-
11	off, sir.
12	MS. SCHMIDT: Thank you.
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
14	(Whereupon, the Show Cause (Status)
15	Hearing was concluded at 10:27 a.m.)
