
ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION

On December 30, 2018, the Metropolitan Police Department closed Sollosso, Inc., t/a El Rincon, (Respondent), under the authority granted by D.C. Official Code § 25-827 based on an incident that occurred on the same day. After an investigation, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board voted to extend the suspension under the authority granted by D.C. Official Code § 25-826. After the Board received a request for a hearing, the parties appeared before the Board on January 9, 2019. At the hearing, the parties proposed an offer-in-compromise, which was accepted by the Board. The Respondent has now fulfilled the conditions of the offer-in-compromise necessary to end the suspension of the Respondent's license.

ORDER

Therefore, the Board, on this 6th day of February 2019, hereby ends the suspension of the Respondent's license and authorizes ABRA to return the license to the Respondent. All other terms and conditions contained in Board Order No. 2018-029 shall remain in full force and effect. A copy of this Order shall be submitted to the parties.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202-879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
