3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The
4	next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-
5	00175, El Tio, License No. 94140.
6	Will the parties, please, approach and
7	identify themselves for the record, please?
8	MS. PHILLIPS: Louise Phillips,
9	Assistant Attorney General, for the District of
10	Columbia.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Phillips.
12	Your name, sir?
13	MR. GUZMAN: Antonio Guzman.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I didn't hear
15	your last name.
16	MR. GUZMAN: Antonio Guzman.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Guzman?
18	MR. GUZMAN: Yes, sir.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
20	Mr. Guzman. And who are you, sir?
21	MR. GUZMAN: I'm general manager of El
22	Tio.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.
2	And you, sir?
3	MR. MEJIA: I am Cesar Mejia. I'm the
4	owner of El Tio.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And who are
6	you?
7	MR. MEJIA: The owner.
8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You're the
9	owner?
10	MR. MEJIA: Yes.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what's your
12	last name, sir?
13	MR. MEJIA: Mejia.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mejia?
15	MR. MEJIA: Um-hum.
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
17	Mr. Mejia.
18	All right. Ms. Phillips, are there
19	any preliminary matters in this case?
20	MS. PHILLIPS: Yes, there are, Mr.
21	Chair. The parties have agreed to an Offer in
22	Compromise which they wish to present to the

1	Board. It's a two charge matter.
2	The first charge is to be dismissed.
3	And the second charge is \$750 fine to be paid
4	within 30 days or the license will be suspended
5	indefinitely.
6	And also, Charge 2, there was a typo.
7	It the code section should be 825 I mean,
8	sorry. 25-823(a)(6) instead of (7).
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. So
10	noted.
11	Mr. Mejia, it's my understanding that
12	there is an Offer in Compromise and the Offer in
13	Compromise is that for there are two charges.
14	That Charge 1 will be dismissed and for Charge 2
15	there is a \$750 fine payable in 30 days. If the
16	fine is not payable in 30 days, the license will
17	be suspended.
18	Is this your understanding, sir, of
19	the Offer in Compromise?
20	MR. MEJIA: (No audible answer.)
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I need you to
22	say yes.

1	MR. MEJIA: Yes, sir.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is it also your
3	understanding are you aware that by accepting
4	an Offer in Compromise, that you are giving up
5	your right to a hearing?
6	MR. MEJIA: Yes, sir.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And are you
8	also aware that by accepting an Offer in
9	Compromise, that you are giving up your right to
10	appeal this matter?
11	MR. MEJIA: Yes, sir.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes?
13	MR. MEJIA: Yes, sir.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
15	This is being recorded, so it has to be on the
16	transcript that you responded affirmatively to my
17	to the questions I asked you, sir, so that's
18	why I am saying that, because I don't it has
19	to be the transcriber has to pick up that you
20	responded. Okay.
21	All right. So with this said, I then
22	make a motion that the Offer in Compromise for El

1	Tio, that the Offer in Compromise for Charge 1,
2	that Charge 1 be dismissed. Charge 2 that there
3	is a \$750 fine payable in 30 days. If the fine
4	is not payable in 30 days, the license will be
5	suspended until the fine has been paid.
6	Is there a second?
7	MEMBER SHORT: Second.
8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
9	seconded the motion.
10	All those in favor say aye.
11	ALL: Aye.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
13	The matter passes 4-0-0.
14	Thank you.
