MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of Felicity Lounge please come forward, the parties in the matter of Felicity Lounge?

This is Case No. 20-PRO-0006, Brothers Burger, LLC, 707 H Street, Northeast, License No. ABRA-112502. This is a Retailer Class CR, Substantial Change, Class CR Restaurant to Class CT Tavern. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet, residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety, and real property values.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Introductions beginning with the applicant, please.

MR. MISKIRI: Good morning, Ms.
Fletcher. Jeffeary Miskiri, J-E-F-F-E-A-R-Y, last name M-I-S-K-I-R-I.

MS. FLETCHER: Jeffeary, what's your last name again?

MR. MISKIRI: Miskiri, M-I-S-K-I-R --$R-I, ~ e x c u s e$ me.

MS. FLETCHER: M-I-S-K-I?
MR. MISKIRI: K-I-R-I.
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, thank you. Thank you. Person on behalf of ANC 6C?

MR. KELTY: Good morning. My name is Commissioner Joel Kelty, J-O-E-L K-E-L-T-Y. I'm here on behalf of ANC 6C.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Kelty. There's a group of 24. Is there anyone present on behalf of the group of 24?

MS. BAUGH: Yes, ma'am. My name is Angelle Smith Baugh, A-N-G-E-L-L-E S-M-I-T-H B-A-U-G-H.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Baugh. Are any individuals present from your group today?

MS. BAUGH: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. If you would just stand right beside Ms. Baugh, there's a microphone on the table and just state your name and spell it for the record. Don't move the microphone.

MR. LUND: Andrew Lund, A-N-D-R-E-W L-U-N-D.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

MR. BAILLAT: David Baillat, D-A-V-I-D B-A-I-L-L-A-T.

MS. FLETCHER: What's the last name? I'm sorry.

MR. BAILLAT: Baillat.
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, could you spell it one more time?

MR. BAILLAT: B-A-I-L-L-A-T.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. KLINE: Jaclyn Kline. It's J-A-C-L-Y-N and last name is K-L-I-N-E.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. MEDLEY: Peter Medley, P-E-T-E-R M-E-D-L-E-Y.

MR. BAUGH: Jordan Baugh, J-O-R-D-A-N B-A-U-G-H.

MS. MADDEN: Carlyn Madden, C-A-R-L-YN --

MS. FLETCHER: I'm sorry. What was the first name?

MS. MADDEN: Carlyn.
MS. FLETCHER: Carlyn?
MS. MADDEN: C-A-R-L-Y-N. Last name Madden, M-A-D-D-E-N.

MR. GEISE: John Geise, J-O-H-N G-E-I-

S-E.
MR. ACKEMANN: Alex Ackemann. It's A-L-E-X A-C-K-E-M-A-N-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
Ackemann. And Angelle Baugh, you're also a protestant? You also signed the protest letter, Mr. Baugh?

MS. BAUGH: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. KELTY: Ms. Fletcher, I have a procedural question --

MS. FLETCHER: Yeah.
MR. KELTY: -- or request. I'd like this matter to be dismissed on the basis that the owner of the applicant is not present.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MR. MISKIRI: That's not true.
MS. FLETCHER: Just a second. I can just respond to that. Mr. Kelty, for the roll call hearing, we'll accept whichever representative you send and including the applicant, including the protestant for the purpose of the roll call hearing.

At the upcoming status hearing. The Board will want to see the owner.

MR. KELTY: Okay. And you have an authorized agent -- an agent authorization for Mr. Miskiri?

MS. FLETCHER: For the purpose of the roll call, it's okay. Whoever shows up, it's okay.

MR. KELTY: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: A designated representative does not have to be officially established until the status hearing.

MR. KELTY: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: You were going to respond to that --

MR. MISKIRI: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: -- Mr. Miskiri?
MR. MISKIRI: If you can talk to your colleague, I was added to the -- as an owner on the license. So maybe he wasn't aware of that, but I am an owner of the establishment.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MR. KELTY: Mr. Fletcher, the ANC is required to receive notification of any change of application to the ownership of the establishment. We did not receive such notification.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MR. KELTY: This will be a contested matter, but I'm willing to set it aside until we get to the actual hearing.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MR. KELTY: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. So Mr. Kelty, I'm making a note of the fact that the ANC did not receive notice of the change in ownership.

MR. KELTY: That's correct. And in addition, $I$ have three times requested a copy of the application for the substantial change from a restaurant to a tavern and $I$ have yet to receive that information. We will require that in order to mount an argument against approval of that application.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. There is also a group of 10. Is there anyone present from the group of $10 ?$ Mr. Kelty, are you representing the group of 10 as well?

MR. KELTY: I'm available to represent the group of 10. I've been authorized to do so. I believe there may be some overlap between the two groups.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MR. KELTY: But I'm happy to represent for the purposes of this meeting.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you. And would any members from that group of 10 please line up between Mr. Baugh and Mr. Kelty? And if you could state your name and spell it for the record.

MS. BAUGH: I'm also a signatory of that letter.

MR. LUND: Andrew Lund, A-N-D-R-E-W L-U-N-D.

MR. BAILLAT: David Baillat, D-A-V-I-D B-A-I-L-L-A-T.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. BAUGH: Jordan Baugh, J-O-R-D-A-N B-A-U-G-H.

MS. MADDEN: Carlyn Madden, C-A-R-L-YN M-A-D-D-E-N.

MR. ACKEMANN: Alex Ackemann, A-L-E-X A-C-K-E-M-A-N-N.

MR. KELTY: She's unsure whether she signed both letters or not.

MS. FLETCHER: Oh, I can let you know.
MR. KELTY: Should we have her name
anyway?
MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, I'll check for you.

MS. KLINE: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Give me one second and I'll tell you. Let me get your name again.

MS. KLINE: Yeah, it's Jaclyn Kline. The last name is $\mathrm{K}-\mathrm{L}-\mathrm{I}-\mathrm{N}-\mathrm{E}$.

MS. FLETCHER: One second. Okay. Ms. Kline, you didn't sign that one.

MS. KLINE: Okay. Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. With respect to the group of 24 , that group has standing as protestants and these nine members from that group are present today. With respect to the group of 10 , the group of 10 is granted full standing today because at least five members from that group are present today.

And present on behalf of ANC 6C, that would be you, Mr. --

MR. KELTY: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: -- Kelty? Thank you. ANC 6C has standing as a protestant. I have a question regarding the group of $24, \mathrm{Ms}$. Baugh.

MS. BAUGH: Mm-hmm.

MS. FLETCHER: In your protest letter, you mentioned that the group of 24 included an abutting property owner. Is that abutting property owner also filing a protest as an abutting property owner or only as a part of the group of 24 ?

MS. BAUGH: So they're part of both the group of 24 and the group of 10.

MS. FLETCHER: This is only related to the abutting property owner.

MS. BAUGH: Correct. I'm saying the abutting property owner has signed both letters.

MS. FLETCHER: Right. Okay. And so I've actually got that part. In the protest letter, it also mentions that the group of 24 includes one abutting property owner.

MS. BAUGH: That's correct.
MS. FLETCHER: So that abutting property owner is filing a separate protest?

MS. BAUGH: No, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Just part of the group?
MS. BAUGH: Correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. I just wanted to clarify that. Thank you very much. Okay. We need to set a date for a mediation status hearing
the protest hearing. And I'll give you the dates for the status and protest hearing first. The date for the status hearing is March 25 at 9:30.

MR. MISKIRI: 9:30?
MS. FLETCHER: 9:30, March 25 at 9:30 for the status hearing. The protest hearing is set for March 29 at 4:30. The protest hearing is -- sorry, April 29 at 4:30 for the protest hearing. And the status hearing is March 25 at 9:30.

MR. KELTY: Okay. So I have Wednesday, March 25th at 9:30 for the status hearing, and I have Wednesday, April 29th at 4:30 for the protest hearing?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MR. KELTY: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. I will give you the next available day for mediation. The next available day is March 12 at pretty much anytime that day between 9:00 and 2:00 in the afternoon. 9:00, 9:30, 10:00, 10:30, whatever time works.

MR. MISKIRI: 12?
MS. FLETCHER: On the 12th.
MR. MISKIRI: The earlier, the better
for me.
MS. FLETCHER: So whatever time is --
MR. KELTY: We can do earlier than that if you'd like. Should we do 10:30, 10:00?

MR. MISKIRI: 10:00 is fine.
MR. KELTY: Did you say 10:00 was
available?
MS. FLETCHER: Mm-ma'am.
MR. KELTY: 10:00 o'clock?
MS. FLETCHER: 10:00 o'clock.
MR. MISKIRI: 10:00 is fine with me.
MR. KELTY: On March 12th at 10:00 o'clock for the mediation, right?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MR. KELTY: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: So mediation is set for Thursday, March 12, 10:00 o'clock a.m. Questions at all?
(No audible response.)
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for coming. See you then.

MR. KELTY: Thank you.
(Whereupon, the above-entitled matter went off the record at 10:22 a.m.)
