4	the matter of Felicity Lounge please come
5	forward, the parties in the matter of Felicity
6	Lounge?
7	This is Case No. 20-PRO-0006, Brothers
8	Burger, LLC, 707 H Street, Northeast, License No.
9	ABRA-112502. This is a Retailer Class CR,
10	Substantial Change, Class CR Restaurant to Class
11	CT Tavern. The protest issues are adverse impact
12	on peace, order and quiet, residential parking
13	and vehicular and pedestrian safety, and real
14	property values.
15	My name is LaVerne Fletcher,
16	conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's
17	agent. Introductions beginning with the
18	applicant, please.
19	MR. MISKIRI: Good morning, Ms.
20	Fletcher. Jeffeary Miskiri, J-E-F-F-E-A-R-Y,
21	last name M-I-S-K-I-R-I.
22	MS. FLETCHER: Jeffeary, what's your
23	last name again?
24	MR. MISKIRI: Miskiri, M-I-S-K-I-R
25	R-I, excuse me.

	MS. FLETCHER: M-I-S-K-I?
2	MR. MISKIRI: K-I-R-I.
3	MS. FLETCHER: Oh, thank you. Thank
4	you. Person on behalf of ANC 6C?
5	MR. KELTY: Good morning. My name is
6	Commissioner Joel Kelty, J-O-E-L K-E-L-T-Y. I'm
7	here on behalf of ANC 6C.
8	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Kelty.
9	There's a group of 24. Is there anyone present
10	on behalf of the group of 24?
11	MS. BAUGH: Yes, ma'am. My name is
12	Angelle Smith Baugh, A-N-G-E-L-L-E S-M-I-T-H B-A-
13	U-G-H.
14	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Baugh.
15	Are any individuals present from your group

7	Mr. Baugh?
8	MS. BAUGH: Yes, ma'am.
9	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
10	MR. KELTY: Ms. Fletcher, I have a
11	procedural question
12	MS. FLETCHER: Yeah.
13	MR. KELTY: or request. I'd like
14	this matter to be dismissed on the basis that the
15	owner of the applicant is not present.
16	MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
17	MR. MISKIRI: That's not true.
18	MS. FLETCHER: Just a second. I can
19	just respond to that. Mr. Kelty, for the roll
20	call hearing, we'll accept whichever
21	representative you send and including the
22	applicant, including the protestant for the
23	purpose of the roll call hearing.
24	At the upcoming status hearing. The
25	Board will want to see the owner.

1	MR. KELTY: Okay. And you have an			
2	authorized agent an agent authorization for			
3	Mr. Miskiri?			
4	MS. FLETCHER: For the purpose of the			
5	roll call, it's okay. Whoever shows up, it's			
6	okay.			
7	MR. KELTY: Thank you.			
8	MS. FLETCHER: A designated			
9	representative does not have to be officially			
10	established until the status hearing.			
11	MR. KELTY: Thank you.			
12	MS. FLETCHER: You were going to			
13	respond to that			
14	MR. MISKIRI: Yes.			
15	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Miskiri?			
16	MR. MISKIRI: If you can talk to your			
17	colleague, I was added to the as an owner on			
18	the license. So maybe he wasn't aware of that,			
19	but I am an owner of the establishment.			
20	MS. FLETCHER: Okay.			
21	MR. KELTY: Mr. Fletcher, the ANC is			
22	required to receive notification of any change of			
23	application to the ownership of the			
24	establishment. We did not receive such			
25	notification.			

1 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. This will be a contested 2 MR. KELTY: matter, but I'm willing to set it aside until we 3 4 get to the actual hearing. 5 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. MR. KELTY: Thank you. 6 7 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. So Mr. 8 Kelty, I'm making a note of the fact that the ANC 9 did not receive notice of the change in 10 ownership. 11 MR. KELTY: That's correct. And in 12 addition, I have three times requested a copy of 13 the application for the substantial change from a 14 restaurant to a tavern and I have yet to receive 15 that information. We will require that in order 16 to mount an argument against approval of that 17 application. 18 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. There is 19 also a group of 10. Is there anyone present from 20 the group of 10? Mr. Kelty, are you representing 21 the group of 10 as well? 22 MR. KELTY: I'm available to represent 23 the group of 10. I've been authorized to do so. 24 I believe there may be some overlap between the

two groups.

9	MS. BAUGH: I'm also a signatory of
10	that letter.
11	MR. LUND: Andrew Lund, A-N-D-R-E-W L-

15	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
16	MR. BAUGH: Jordan Baugh, J-O-R-D-A-N

16	group of 10, the group of 10 is granted full
17	standing today because at least five members from
18	that group are present today.
19	And present on behalf of ANC 6C, that
20	would be you, Mr
21	MR. KELTY: Yes.
22	MS. FLETCHER: Kelty? Thank you.
23	ANC 6C has standing as a protestant. I have a
24	question regarding the group of 24, Ms. Baugh.
25	MS. BAUGH: Mm-hmm.

1	MS. FLETCHER: In your protest letter,
2	you mentioned that the group of 24 included an
3	abutting property owner. Is that abutting
4	property owner also filing a protest as an
5	abutting property owner or only as a part of the
6	group of 24?
7	MS. BAUGH: So they're part of both
8	the group of 24 and the group of 10.
9	MS. FLETCHER: This is only related to
10	the abutting property owner.
11	MS. BAUGH: Correct. I'm saying the
12	abutting property owner has signed both letters.
13	MS. FLETCHER: Right. Okay. And so
14	I've actually got that part. In the protest
15	letter, it also mentions that the group of 24
16	includes one abutting property owner.
17	MS. BAUGH: That's correct.
18	MS. FLETCHER: So that abutting
19	property owner is filing a separate protest?
20	MS. BAUGH: No, ma'am.
21	MS. FLETCHER: Just part of the group?
22	MS. BAUGH: Correct.
23	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. I just wanted to
24	clarify that. Thank you very much. Okay. We
25	need to set a date for a mediation status hearing

the protest hearing. And I'll give you the dates 1 2 for the status and protest hearing first. 3 date for the status hearing is March 25 at 9:30. 4 MR. MISKIRI: 9:30? 5 MS. FLETCHER: 9:30, March 25 at 9:30 for the status hearing. The protest hearing is 6 7 set for March 29 at 4:30. The protest hearing is 8 -- sorry, April 29 at 4:30 for the protest 9 hearing. And the status hearing is March 25 at 9:30. 10 11 MR. KELTY: Okay. So I have 12 Wednesday, March 25th at 9:30 for the status 13 hearing, and I have Wednesday, April 29th at 4:30 14 for the protest hearing? 15 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. 16 MR. KELTY: Thank you. 17 You're welcome. MS. FLETCHER: I will 18 give you the next available day for mediation. 19 The next available day is March 12 at pretty much 20 anytime that day between 9:00 and 2:00 in the 21 afternoon. 9:00, 9:30, 10:00, 10:30, whatever 22 time works. 23 12? MR. MISKIRI: 24 MS. FLETCHER: On the 12th. 25 The earlier, the better MR. MISKIRI:
