ORDER VACATING CEASE AND DESIST

On March 25, 2021, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2021-154 ordering Sunrise Grocery, Inc., t/a Food 7 Store (Licensee), holder of a Retailer’s B License No. ABRA-108479, to stop selling alcoholic beverages at Licensee’s establishment. The Board’s Order resulted from the dismissal of the Licensee’s renewal application on February 22, 2021. *See* Board Order No. 2021-089. The Licensee failed to remedy the dismissal and continued to operate on an expired license.

On March 31, 2021, the Licensee filed a second renewal application and is now permitted to resume operations.

It is hereby **ORDERED**, that the **ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST** issued against Sunrise Grocery, Inc., t/a Food 7 Store, by the Board on March 25, 2021, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), be and hereby is **VACATED**.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
