

The Application filed by FountainInn, LLC, t/a Fountain Inn (Applicant), for a new Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on October 13, 2020.

At the Roll Call Hearing, the Protestants Frank E. Loy and Henry Bartow Farr did not produce evidence proving that their property abuts the Applicant's establishment and as a result, the Board's Agent granted Mr. Loy and Mr. Farr conditional standing. The Board's Agent advised Mr. Loy and Mr. Farr that they would need to produce evidence proving that their property abuts the Applicant's establishment at the Protest Status Hearing in order for the Board to confer full standing.

On October 13, 2020, the Board dismissed the Protest of Abigail Gillis because Abigail Gillis is neither a member of a Group of Five or More Individuals nor an abutting property owner. Abigail Gillis may file a Request for Reinstatement of her Protest with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

ORDER

The Board does hereby, this 21st day of October, 2020, **DISMISS** the Protest of Abigail Gillis. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Parties.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
