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**ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF NEW APPLICATION**

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The Application filed by Foxtrot Retail D.C., LLC, t/a Foxtrot (Applicant), for a New Retailer's Class B License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on June 21, 2022, and a Protest Status Hearing on July 20, 2022.

On July 20, 2022, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. *See* Board Order 2022-473.

On August 1, 2022, Sidon Yohannes, Counsel, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement. Ms. Yohannes explained that she did not appear at the Protest Status Hearing due to a personal emergency. Ms. Yohannes notes that the ANC 2F

consents to the reinstatement of the Application. It is the parties desire to continue working towards a final Settlement Agreement.

Upon consideration of this uncontested request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that the Applicant's request constitutes good cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

### **ORDER**

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 3rd day of August 2022, **REINSTATE** the Application filed by Foxtrot Retail D.C., LLC, t/a Foxtrot, for a New Retailer's Class B License. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the parties.

The Board advises the parties that the Protest Hearing is set for September 14, 2022, at 1:30 p.m.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
