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**ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF NEW APPLICATION**

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The Application filed by Foxtrot Retail D.C., LLC, t/a Foxtrot (Applicant), for a New Retailer’s Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on June 21, 2022, and a Protest Status Hearing on July 20, 2022.

On July 20, 2022, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. *See* Board Order 2022-472.

On August 1, 2022, Sidon Yohannes, Counsel, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement. Ms. Yohannes explained that she did not appear at the Protest Status Hearing due to a personal emergency. Ms. Yohannes notes that the ANC 2F

consents to the reinstatement of the Application. It is the parties desire to continue working towards a final Settlement Agreement.

Upon consideration of this uncontested request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that the Applicant's request constitutes good cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

### **ORDER**

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 3rd day of August 2022, **REINSTATE** the Application filed by Foxtrot Retail D.C., LLC, t/a Foxtrot, for a New Retailer's Class CR License. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the parties.

The Board advises the parties that the Protest Hearing is set for September 14, 2022, at 1:30 p.m.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010).

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
