3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in  
4 the matter of Foxtrot please come forward, the  
5 parties of the matter of Foxtrot. This is Case  
6 No. 20-PRO-00010, Foxtrot Retail DC, 1267  
7 Wisconsin Ave., NW, License ABRA 115514, Retailer  
8 Class B new application.

9 The protest issues are adverse impact  
10 on peace, order, and quiet. My name is La Verne  
11 Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing as the  
12 Board's agent. Introductions, beginning with the  
13 applicant, please.

14 MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on behalf  
15 of the applicant, and that's S-I-D-O-N Y-O-H-A-N-  
16 N-E-S.

17 MS. FLETCHER: And present on behalf  
18 of ANC 2E.

19 MS. PALMER: Lisa Palmer.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Palmer, could you  
21 spell that for the record, please.

22 MS. PALMER: L-I-S-A, last name is  
23 Palmer, P-A-L-M-E-R.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.  
25 ANC 2E has standing as a protestant. We need to

1 set a date for a mediation, a status hearing, and  
2 a protest hearing. I'll give you the date for  
3 the status and protest hearing first.

4 The status hearing is set for March  
5 18, 2020 at 9:30 a.m., that's March 18, 2020 at  
6 9:30 for the status hearing

7 The protest hearing is set for April  
8 8, 2020 at 1:30.

9 MS. PALMER: Yeah, I would expect that  
10 you'll have a settlement agreement today.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Today?

12 MS. PALMER: Yes.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, today, oh.

14 (Laughter.)

15 MS. FLETCHER: Well then, in that  
16 case, no dates will be scheduled. And would you  
17 submit that today or beyond today?

18 MS. PALMER: As long as I can sign it,  
19 the applicant's already signed it.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

21 MS. PALMER: I wanted to be a party to  
22 the agreement.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

24 MS. PALMER: Even though their letter  
25 came late.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. But either way  
2 you want to do it is fine. Yes, we can wait,  
3 yes. Well, then --

4 MS. PALMER: But I know they will, I  
5 mean, I'm confident.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Exactly. Okay, well,  
7 thanks for that, Ms. Palmer. No dates necessary.  
8 I'll just make a note of that and let the Board  
9 know that the matter was settled already.

10 Okay, well, that roll call hearing is  
11 concluded. Thank you.

12 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.
