Any outstanding quarterly 4 5 payments will be filed within 60 days. Mr. Short 6 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say 7 aye. (Chorus of aye.) 8 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed. 10 MEMBER CROCKETT: Nay. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The matter 12 passes 3 to 1 with Ms. Crockett against. Ms. 13 Crockett. Okay. All right.
