3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

4 Then the next case is Case No. 17-AUD-00041, Fuel
5 Pizza & Wings, License No. 88452.

6 And it's the same parties. Is there
7 any preliminary matters in this case?

8 MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, there is. The
9 licensee -- there is an Offer in Compromise which
10 consists of the licensee paying \$2,000 within 60
11 days and if not paid within 60 days, the license
12 will remain suspended until it is paid.

13 And I have been informed that this
14 report has been filed.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Again, Ms.
16 Ember, it's my understanding that there is an
17 Offer in Compromise that there is a fine of
18 \$2,000 payable in 60 days. If the fine is not
19 payable within 60 days, the license will be
20 suspended. Is this your understanding of the
21 Offer in Compromise?

22 MS. EMBER: Yes, that is correct.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
2 that by accepting or is your client aware that by
3 accepting an Offer in Compromise, that they are
4 giving up their right to a hearing?

5 MS. EMBER: Yes.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And that they
7 are also giving up their right to appeal this
8 matter?

9 MS. EMBER: Yes.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hearing that,
11 I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise
12 of a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days be
13 accepted. If the fine is not payable in 60 days,
14 the license will be suspended until compliance.
15 Is there a second?

16 MEMBER ISAAC: Second.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Isaac has
18 seconded the motion.

19 All those in favor say aye.

20 ALL: Aye.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All those
22 opposed? The matter passes 5-0-0.

1 Thank you very much. I'll have you
2 sign-off on this matter. And I thank the parties
3 for agreeing to this matter. Okay. Thank you.
