3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The			
4	next case on our calendar is Case No. 17-CMP-			
5	00659, Full Kee Restaurant, License No. 73951.			
6	Is there an interpreter in this case?			
7	INTERPRETER FANG: I'm the			
8	interpreter.			
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can you raise			
10	your hand, please, ma'am?			
11	INTERPRETER FANG: Yes.			
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do you swear or			
13	affirm to faithfully translate these proceedings			
14	from it's from Mandarin? What is it?			
15	INTERPRETER FANG: Yes, Mandarin			
16	Chinese.			
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: From Mandarin			
18	Chinese to English and from English to Mandarin			
19	Chinese?			
20	INTERPRETER FANG: Yes, I do.			
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good. Have a			
22	seat, please.			

1	INTERPRETER FANG: Okay.			
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Would the			
3	parties, please, state their name for the record,			
4	please? Mr. Sousa?			
5	MR. SOUSA: Christopher Sousa for the			
6	District of Columbia.			
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,			
8	Mr. Sousa. Can you state your name for the			
9	record, please?			
10	INTERPRETER FANG: What?			
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Them. They			
12	need I need them to tell me their names.			
13	INTERPRETER FANG: Oh.			
14	MR. TAN: Xi Qiu Tan.			
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can you			
16	MR. TAN: Xi Qiu Tan.			
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: spell it			
18	also, too, please?			
19	MR. TAN: S-I Q-I-U and Tan, T-A-N,			
20	the last name.			
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.			
22	Thank you. And have him write it on that piece			

1	of paper right there, too, please.			
2	Can I also have her introduce her			
3	name, please, herself?			
4	MS. WU: My name is Mie Xian Wu.			
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And could we			
6	also spell that, too, please?			
7	MS. WU: M-I-E S-I-A-N W-U.			
8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. And			
9	if she can write it on the sheet. And, ma'am,			
10	you can as the Interpreter, you can also write			
11	your name on the sheet, too, please.			
12	INTERPRETER FANG: Okay.			
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are there any			
14	preliminary matters in this case?			
15	MR. SOUSA: There are. There is an			
16	Offer in Compromise to present to the Board.			
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is the			
18	Offer in Compromise?			
19	MR. SOUSA: That Offer in Compromise			
20	for Charge 1, failure to file required quarterly			
21	statement, there is a \$350 fine and submission of			
22	the second quarter 2017 statement. Payment of			

1	the fine if not received, will result in the
2	license being suspended or revoked.
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: In?
4	MR. SOUSA: Within 30 days.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do you know,
6	Mr. Sousa, if this covers all the outstanding
7	quarterly I'm sorry, filings?
8	MR. SOUSA: This charge is only for
9	the failure to file the second quarter of 2017
LO	filing. So this charge doesn't cover any other
L1	filings that they may have missed.
L2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I'm
L3	sorry, when is it is there a time line to file
L 4	the second the outstanding filings?
L5	MR. SOUSA: There is not. I can
L6	consult with the other side. Do you want me to
L7	run through the OIC again?
L8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, please.
L9	MR. SOUSA: Okay. The OIC to be
20	presented to the Board is payment of a \$350 fine
21	within 30 days. If the payment is not received,
22	the license will be suspended. And also the

1	filing of the second quarter 2017 Quarterly				
2	Statement within 30 days.				
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.				
4	INTERPRETER FANG: Excuse me, you said				
5	2017?				
6	MR. ANDERSON: Yeah, the second				
7	quarter of 2017.				
8	INTERPRETER FANG: Oh. She is unsure.				
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That's it?				
10	MR. SOUSA: Yes.				
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.				
12	It's my understanding that there is an Offer in				
13	Compromise. And the Offer in Compromise is that				
14	there is a fine of \$350 payable in 30 days. If				
15	the fine is not payable within 30 days, the				
16	license will be suspended. And that also the				
17	second quarter statements for 2017 will also be				
18	filed within 30 days.				
19	MS. WU: Okay.				
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is this your				
21	understanding of the Offer in Compromise?				
22	Ms. WU: Yes.				

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I need you to
2	vocalize it, ma'am. I can't hear you, so you
3	have to say yes.
4	INTERPRETER FANG: Oh, I asked her
5	if
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No. You need
7	to tell me that she said yes.
8	MS. WU: Yes.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Right.
10	INTERPRETER FANG: She said she would
11	do it.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Right. Is she
13	aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,
14	that she is giving up her right to a hearing?
15	INTERPRETER FANG: Giving up what?
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is she aware
17	that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that
18	she is giving up her right to have a hearing?
19	MS. WU: Yes.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is she also
21	aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,
22	that she is giving up her right to appeal this

1 matter? 2 MS. WU: Yes. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 3 With that said, I then make a motion that the 4 5 Offer in Compromise be accepted and the Offer in Compromise is a fine of \$350 payable in 30 days. 6 7 And the second quarter payment paid within 30 8 The second quarter filings, I'm sorry. days. 9 MS. WU: Yeah. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And if it's not 10 11 done, the license will be suspended until 12 compliance has been made. Is there a second? 13 MEMBER SHORT: Second. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has 15 seconded the motion. 16 All those in favor say aye. 17 ALL: Aye. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All those 19 The matter passes 5-0-0. We have opposed? 20 accepted the Offer in Compromise. 21 So we are going to have you sign some 22 paperwork now to formalize it. Okay? All right.

1	MR. TAN: Thank you.			
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: It's over. All			
3	right. Now that this case is over, it is my			
4	understanding that there might be some other			
5	outstanding payments quarterly filings.			
6	Since the translator is here, we are			
7	going to have you meet with Monica Clark and she			
8	can explain to you the process of what is			
9	missing. Okay? So			
10	MS. WU: Okay.			
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So			
12	I'm going to have you can have them sign this			
13	paperwork and then they can stay in the back and			
14	you stay with them to have Ms. Clark explain to			
15	them what is needed.			
16	INTERPRETER FANG: Oh, okay.			
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So you guys can			
18	wait in the back and she will talk to you. Okay?			
19	INTERPRETER FANG: Okay, yes.			
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.			
21	(Whereupon, the Show Cause (Status)			
22	Hearing was concluded at 10:05 a.m.)
