CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

The next case on our calendar is Case Number 19-CIT-00315, Georgetown Inn, License Number 88198.

Would the parties please approach and identify themselves for the record, please?

MR. LUI: John Lui, on behalf of the Government.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Lui.

MR. MINORA: Matthew Minora, on behalf of the Licensee.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr. Minora.

MR. MINORA: Good morning.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are there preliminary matters in this case?

MR. LUI: Yes, Mr. Chairperson.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is that, sir?

MR. LUI: There is an offer in compromise to present to the Board.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is that?

MR. LUI: For Charge 1, no ABC

1 manager, the offer in compromise is a \$1,250
2 fine, made payable within 30 days or its license
3 shall be suspended indefinitely until this fine
4 is paid.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
6 Mr. Minora, it's my understanding that there is
7 an offer in compromise.

8 And the offer in compromise, that
9 there is a fine of \$1,250, payable within 30
10 days. If the fine is not paid within 30 days,
11 the license will be suspended.

12 Is this you and your client's
13 understanding of the offer in compromise?

14 MR. MINORA: Yes, that's correct.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client
16 aware that by accepting an offer in compromise,
17 that they're giving up their right to a hearing?

18 MR. MINORA: That is correct.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client
20 also aware that by accepting an offer in
21 compromise that they're also giving up their
22 right to appeal this matter?

23 MR. MINORA: That is correct.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that
25 said, I make a motion that the offer in

1 compromise of a fine of \$1,250, payable within
2 30 days, be accepted. If the fine is not paid
3 within 30 days, the license will be suspended
4 until the fine has been paid.

5 Is there a second?

6 MEMBER CROCKETT: Second.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett
8 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
9 say aye.

10 (Chorus of ayes.)

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
12 The matter passes, 4-0-0.

13 MR. MINORA: Thank you.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
