Settlement Agreement Between ANC3B and Ghost Kitchen LLC t/a Ghostline DC

This is an agreement between Ghost Kitchen LLC t/a Ghostline DC (hereafter "Ghostline") holder of a Class CR alcoholic beverage license (ABRA license #117089) for its premises at 2340 Wisconsin Avenue NW, and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3B (hereafter "ANC3B").

Ghostline and ANC3B wish to agree to the following terms of a Settlement Agreement listed below. This Agreement is intended to replace the Voluntary Agreement currently attached to the license that had been negotiated with a previous establishment at this location. This Agreement more accurately reflects the operations of Ghostline and is intended to remove the restriction against live music on the rear patio so that Ghostline can apply for an entertainment endorsement.

It is therefore agreed between Ghostline and ANC3B:

- 1. Ghostline agrees that the second floor outside deck will be closed at midnight, Sunday through Thursday, and at 1 am Friday and Saturday.
- Ghostline commits to maintaining neighbor-friendly noise levels both downstairs and upstairs, inside and outside, front and back, and will provide its managers and wait staff with strategies for noise control and instruct them to deal promptly with any and all instances of excessive noise.
 - 2a. Excessive noise is defined as noise that causes neighbors to complain because it is disrupting the peace and quiet inside their homes, or noise that any reasonable person would recognize as not neighbor-friendly.
- 3. Ghostline agrees to seek an entertainment endorsement for any live music performances inside or outside if the entertainment is scheduled after 6:30 pm, as required by the regulations governing its liquor license.
 - 3a. ANC3B agrees to support a stipulated entertainment endorsement once the terms of this Agreement are accepted by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Both parties understand that no live music performances are permitted until the COVID-19 emergency restrictions are ended.

- 4. Ghostline agrees to the following limitations on live music performances:
 - 4a. Live entertainment will feature only jazz music.
 - 4b. Live music will end no later than 11 pm on Wednesday, Thursday, and Sunday, and no later than midnight on Friday and Saturday. No performances will be scheduled on Monday or Tuesday.
 - 4c. Live jazz performances will be held no more than three times per week. Ghostline agrees to begin with one performance a week and increase the frequency of live entertainment after it is clear that the music does not disrupt the peace and quiet of its residential neighbors.
 - 4d. Ghostline agrees to use a licensed sound engineer to ensure that live music will not be heard inside the homes of near neighbors. Performances will be staged under the covered part of the patio and baffling will be positioned around the perimeter to help contain the sound.

The provisions of this Agreement shall become part of the conditions of Ghostline's liquor license and shall remain in force upon renewal or transfer of the license. Violations of this agreement are subject to enforcement by the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration as well as to protest of the March 2022 license renewal by ANC3B.
