The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

7	Will the parties, please, approach and
8	identify themselves for the record, please?
9	MS. VOGEL: Sir, I'm Danielle Vogel,
10	the owner of Glen's Garden Market.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You are the
12	who?
13	MS. VOGEL: Danielle Vogel, the owner
14	of Glen's Garden Market.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
16	Ms. Vogel.
17	MS. GEPHARDT: And again, Chrissy
18	Gephardt here on behalf of the Office of the
19	Attorney General.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
21	Ms. Gephardt.
22	Are there any preliminary matters in

1 this case?

MS. GEPHARDT: Yes, there is a preliminary matter. In this case, the parties have agreed on an Offer in Compromise to consist of the following:

For Charge 1, it would be a \$4,000 fine to be paid within 30 days. If the fine is not paid within 30 days, the license would be suspended indefinitely.

The license will also be suspended for 10 days with six days stayed for one year and four days served. And the licensee would like those four days to be December the 26th through -

MS. VOGEL: The 29th.

MS. GEPHARDT: -- the 29th. Thank you. And all employees who serve alcoholic beverages in the establishment must complete an alcohol training program within three months of the date of the Offer in Compromise.

And Charge 2 would be dismissed.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,

1 Ms. Vogel. It's my understanding that there is 2 an Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that for Charge 1, there is a fine 3 4 of \$4,000 payable within 30 days. 5 Also with Charge 1, there is a 10 day 6 suspension, six days of the suspension will be 7 stayed for one year, provided that there is no 8 further violation within the year, that four days 9 will be served. So you have to serve a four day The four days that will be served 10 suspension. 11 will be December 26th through December 29, 2018. 12 That all employees who sell or serve alcohol will undergo training within 90 days. 13 And that Charge 2 will be dismissed. 14 15 Is this your understanding of the 16 Offer in Compromise? 17 MS. VOGEL: It is my understanding. 18 Can I ask one question? 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, ma'am. 20 MS. VOGEL: Okay. I understand that 21 it is standard practice for ABRA to take possession of the license during the period of 22

suspension, but the suspension would expire on a Saturday and, therefore, I wouldn't be able to reclaim the license for an additional day following the period of suspension.

So I just wanted to clarify that I will be able to maintain possession of the license and that it will go back into effect at the immediate expiration of the suspension.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We will work
the mechanics out, ma'am, but I think that you
and the Government did agree to the days that the
license will be suspended and the license will be
suspended for those days and we will -- the
Agency will work out the mechanics of how to
return the license to you. I guess you are
saying that you want to be back in operation on
December 30th, which is what day?

MS. VOGEL: A Sunday, sir.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Which is a Sunday. And Charge 2 will be dismissed. But outside of -- with that -- with working out the mechanics of the return of the license, is this

your understanding of the Offer in Compromise?

MS. VOGEL: Yes, sir.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that you are giving up your right to a hearing?

MS. VOGEL: I am. I am aware of that.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that you are giving up your right to appeal this matter?

MS. VOGEL: Yes, sir.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With this said,
I make a motion, I then make a motion that the
Offer in Compromise of for Charge 1, there is a
fine of \$4,000 payable in 30 days. There is a 10
day suspension, six days will be stayed for one
year, providing that there is no subsequent
violation within that one year. Four days will
be served. The four days that will be served are
December 26 through December 29, 2018. That all
employees who sell or serve alcohol will undergo
training within 90 days. And that Charge 2 will

1 be dismissed.

Is there a second?

MEMBER SHORT: Second.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has seconded the motion. Any questions by any Board Members?

Hearing none, all those in favor say aye.

ALL: Aye.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed? The matter passes 6-0-0.

The Board will issue a Board Order and so the 30 days will start once the Board Order has been issued.

And the Agency will work out the mechanics of how the license will be returned to you, so you could operate on the Sunday. But I don't know when the Agency will return the license, but I want to make you -- make it perfectly clear, that you have agreed that your license will be suspended the 26th through the 29th and during that period of time under no

circumstances can you serve alcohol.

So if your -- your business can be open, but alcohol cannot be served during that period of time. And I don't know what the Agency is going to do and return your license, but if it's returned to you prior to the suspension being lifted, you are on notice that it cannot be used during that period of time. Okay?

MS. VOGEL: Understood. I'm sorry, I have one more question. I have both a Class B and a Class D License. This violation --

MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Please, speak up,
Ms. Vogel.

MS. VOGEL: This violation pertains to the sale of off-site packaged alcohol. And it was my understanding that it does not impact our on-site alcohol license.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I don't know, ma'am. I don't know if this -- I can't respond to that information, but the Agency will give you clear and concise clarifications of what is it that you agreed to today.

I do hope that based on the violation that has occurred, that it's a punishment.

MS. VOGEL: Oh, it certainly is a punishment, sir. You're --

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But what I'm saying is it's a punishment and so if you have two class of license, then it doesn't appear that there is any punishment here, because you might still have an active license. But this is something that I will ask that in the Board Order is clearly articulated what is it that you can or cannot do during that period of time.

I wasn't aware that you had two licenses, but I will make sure that since the Agency will be writing a Board Order, the Board Order will clearly articulate what activities as far as alcohol sales that can occur during the period of suspension.

MS. VOGEL: Okay. I just want to affirm that I am deeply aware that this is a punishment. Losing our license for four days and handing over the entirety of our summer profits

is a significant blow to my small business. So the fact that this is a punishment is certainly not in dispute.

this to you, ma'am, this is a sale -- one of the major charges is a Sale to Minor. And a sale to minor is unforgivable, because it's unexcusable. There is what should be considered a 100 percent -- a 100 percent is that you should -- anyone who comes to your establishment, even if they are your mother and if you know how old your mom or your dad is, even if they are a friend, even if you know, you should ask for proof of age.

And if you ask for that, you will never come back here. You are serving a four day suspension. You have six days that are stayed for another year.

MS. VOGEL: Um-hum.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And if those -if you commit another violation within another
year, you will be faced with a six day suspension
and with an even larger fine.

2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And these are
3	all they are all within your control, so I
4	would hope so.

6	a good day. All right.
