ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration (ABCA) has reviewed its records and determined that Good Food Market, LLC, t/a Good Food Markets (Respondent), has failed to pay the third-year license fees for its license by September 30, 2022, the deadline for all Retailer's Class B licenses, despite being notified by ABCA of the payment date.

On April 5, 2023, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against the Respondent pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to pay the third-year license fees for the Retailer's Class B License. The Respondent did not respond to the Order to Cease and Desist.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 12th day of April 2023, that Good Food Markets, LLC's License No. ABRA-098178 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent.

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
