8	MR. SOUSA: Christopher Sousa for the
9	District of Columbia.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
11	again, Mr. Sousa.
12	MR. FARMER: Jonathan Farmer, counsel
13	for Green Island.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
15	Mr. Farmer.
16	MR. WOLDEMARIAM: Muhari Woldemariam
17	from Green Island.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
19	again, Mr I'm sorry, give me your name again,
20	sir.
21	MR. WOLDEMARIAM: Muhari Woldemariam.
22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr.

3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.			
4	Are there any preliminary matters in this case,

9	Offer in Compromise?			
10	MR. SOUSA: For Charge 1, a violation			
11	of settlement agreement, the Offer in Compromise			
12	is payment of \$2,000 within 30 days.			
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And?			
14	MR. SOUSA: That is all. There is			
15	only one charge.			
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And if not			
17	paid?			
18	MR. SOUSA: And if not paid, the			
19	license will be revoked.			
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you, Mr.			
21	Sousa.			
22	MR. SOUSA: Thank you.			

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Farmer,
2	it's my understanding that there is an Offer in
3	Compromise. And the Offer in Compromise is that
4	there is a fine of \$2,000 payable in 30 days. If
5	the fine is not payable in 30 days, the license
6	will be suspended.
7	Is this your understanding, sir, of
8	the Offer in Compromise?
9	MR. FARMER: Yes. Can we speak
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do the parties
11	why don't
12	MR. FARMER: for a second?
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, sure. Go
14	ahead.
15	MR. FARMER: Can we do payment within
16	60 days?
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: It's not Mr.
18	Sousa, you are providing to me the Offer in
19	Compromise and so why don't you let me know what
20	the Offer in Compromise is.
21	MR. SOUSA: The Offer in Compromise is
22	now payment of \$2,000 within 60 days. If payment

1	is not received, the license will be suspended.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Mr.
3	Farmer, it's my understanding that there is an
4	Offer in Compromise. And the Offer in Compromise
5	is that there is a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60
6	days. If the fine is not payable in 60 days, the
7	license will be suspended.
8	Is this your understanding, sir, of
9	the Offer in Compromise?
10	MR. FARMER: Yes.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is your
12	client aware that by accepting an Offer in
13	Compromise, that he is giving up his right to a
14	hearing?
15	MR. FARMER: Yes.
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And your client
17	is also aware that by accepting the Offer in
18	Compromise, that he is giving up his right to
19	appeal this matter?
20	MR. FARMER: That's correct.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hearing that,
22	I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise

1	of a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days be
2	accepted. If the fine is not payable in 60 days,
3	the license will be suspended until compliance
4	has been made. Is there a second?
5	MEMBER SHORT: Second.
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
7	seconded the motion.
8	All those in favor say aye.
9	ALL: Aye.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All those
11	opposed? The matter passes 5-0-0.
12	Thank you very much and thank the
13	parties for this Offer in Compromise.
14	Hold on a minute. We will have you
15	sign some paperwork to formalize this. Thank
16	you.
