3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Alright. The	
4	next case in our calendar is Case No. 19-AUD-	
5	00081. Guapo's Restaurant. License No. 16332.	
6	The Government's microphone is his is already	
7	on.	
8	And, Ms. Andrews, if we have the	
9	licensee for Guapo's Restaurant, could you please	
10	elevate their rights, please.	
11	MS. ANDREWS: Mr. Markowitz, your	
12	rights have been elevated.	
13	MR. MARKOWITZ: Okay. I am here.	
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.	
15	Can we have the parties please	
16	introduce themselves for the record and spell	
17	their name, starting with the Government, please.	
18	Mr. Ortiz?	
19	MR. ORTIZ: Yes. My apologies. Steve	
20	Ortiz on behalf of the District of Columbia.	
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And can we have	
22	you, Mr. Markowitz, can you please say and spell	
23	your name for the record, please, and identify	
24	your affiliation?	
25	MR. MARKOWITZ: Yes, sir. Barry	

Markowitz, B-A-R-R-Y, M-A-R-K-O-W-I-T-Z. 1 I am 2 their CPA for the business and that's my 3 association with Guapo's Restaurant. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Who is the owner 4 5 of the restaurant? Is there -- normally we need to have an owner, someone who's on the -- let me 6 7 ask a question. 8 Mr. Ortiz, is there any preliminary 9 matters in this case? 10 MR. ORTIZ: There are no preliminary 11 matters at this time. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Alright. Thank 13 you, Mr. Ortiz. 14 Mr. Markowitz, and anyone, if you are 15 on to represent this establishment, you need to 16 provide a -- and I don't know. I've not been 17 told whether or not this has been done, but you 18 need to provide the Agency with a letter of 19 authorization from the establishment stating that 20 you are authorized to speak -- to represent 21 Guapo's Restaurant at this ABC hearing. 22 MR. MARKOWITZ: Yes, sir. 23 That has been provided to Mr. Ortiz. 24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry. 25 Mr. Ortiz, have you been provided a

letter saying that Mr. Markowitz is able to 1 2 represent the establishment? 3 MR. ORTIZ: Yes. So, I'll just give you a brief history on this. This case derived 4 5 from -- prior to the pandemic. So, we were in negotiations and then 6 7 he -- Mr. Markowitz did provide me with the 8 letter from Guapo's back in March. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Alright. 10 what I'll ask, Mr. Ortiz, is that, in the future, 11 please let me know because normally, if we 12 meeting in person, then I would ask that I would 13 ask that it be provided to me and I would just ask that I be informed. 14 15 If the person does not identify as the 16 owner, I need the record that an authorization --17 Mr. Markowitz, please mute your phone, please. 18 MR. MARKOWITZ: I apologize. 19 couldn't -- there was something going on with the 20 video -- I mean, the audio. I couldn't really 21 hear what you said. I apologize. 22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That's what --23 I'm asking you to mute your phone. Then you will 24 be able to hear me. That's better. 25 So, I was just saying to Mr. Ortiz

that -- just let me know that the representative of the establishment has provided authorization so I will know to move forward.

Alright. Thank you, then, Mr. Ortiz, and for the representation. And you have stated that there are no preliminary matters; is that correct?

MR. ORTIZ: That is correct.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Then this matter is then -- it will be scheduled for a show cause hearing at a date to be determined and we will contact both the licensee -- the licensee and the Government.

I will -- if you're able to continue speaking about this case to see if it can be settled -- if it's not settled, then we will provide some dates when we will have the show cause hearing (status).

And what I'll ask, Mr. Ortiz, if you have not provided the letter of authorization to the Agency, can you please provide the Agency with a copy of the authorization so at least the Agency will share with me so that if we do move forward with an OIC oral hearing, I don't have to ask that question again. Okay?

MR. ORTIZ: Understood. I will give 1 2 that to you during the break. 3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Alright. Thank 4 you very much. 5 If there are no other concerns, then this matter is adjourned. Thank you very much. 6 7 MR. MARKOWITZ: Okay. So, then we will be notified when the date is that we're supposed 8 9 to appear later on; is that correct? 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes. The Agency 11 will notify if there is no -- if this is going to 12 go into a show cause hearing, the Agency will 13 notify you when the date of the hearing --14 because of the pandemic, we are not -- normally 15 at a show cause hearing we'll let you know when 16 the next hearing is, but we're still trying to 17 figure out how to do this. 18 So, this is actually the first full 19 day since the pandemic has started. This is 20 actually the first full day that we're having a 21 full calendar of hearings. 22 So, we'll let you know when the date -- the next date of the hearing. If there is 23 24 some type of conflict, you can work with Mr. 25 Ortiz and the Agency if the date is not a date

that works for you, sir. Okay? 1 2 MR. MARKOWITZ: Okay. Alright. Thank 3 you very much and -- so, we don't need to do 4 anything else at this time until we receive the 5 date? CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Right. 6 However, 7 you and Mr. Ortiz, if you guys want to come up to 8 some agreement, you can continue talking --9 MR. MARKOWITZ: Okay. 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: -- if you 11 believe an agreement will be reached. 12 you will be notified when the next hearing is. 13 Alright. Thank you very much. 14 MR. MARKOWITZ: So, Mr. Ortiz then will 15 notify me or contact me or --16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No. The Agency 17 -- the same way you got notice today -- for 18 today's hearing, the Agency will notify you when 19 the show cause hearing is scheduled for. 20 MR. MARKOWITZ: Okay. 21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, we will 22 serve on the establishment the date when the show 23 cause hearing is scheduled for. 24 The same way the establishment was 25 notified that this hearing was scheduled for

today, you will also be notified in that same 1 2 manner when the show cause hearing is scheduled 3 for. 4 MR. MARKOWITZ: Right. But you had 5 said that if me and Mr. Ortiz can come up to a solution prior to that, then we would not have 6 7 the hearing; is that correct? 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That is -- what 9 would occur if you and Mr. Ortiz have a -- come 10 up with an agreement, then the hearing -- we'd 11 schedule the hearing and -- we'd schedule the 12 hearing and you would come to an agreement on the 13 record because you have to appear at another 14 hearing. 15 Even if you have an agreement --16 MR. MARKOWITZ: Okay. 17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: -- you have to 18 appear at a hearing to put that on the record. 19 MR. MARKOWITZ: Okay. Alright. Thank 20 you, sir. 21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Alright. 22 MR. MARKOWITZ: Is Mr. Ortiz then going to contact me if we can then come to a solution 23 24 or is his offer from before the only solution? 25 MR. ORTIZ: I will contact you and we

1	will continue our negotiations.			
2	MR. MARKOWITZ: Okay. Alright. Thank			
3	you very much, sir. Appreciate it.			
4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Have a great day			
5	then. Thanks.			
6	MR. MARKOWITZ: Okay.
