The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4	on our calendar is Case No. 17-CC-00144, Guilford
5	Liquor, License No. 76393.
6	Will the parties, please, approach and
7	identify themselves for the record, please?
8	Is there someone here from Guilford
9	Liquor?
10	MR. PARK: Yes, we are here.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You can come
12	over to this side, sir, and, please, identify
13	yourself for the record, sir.
14	MR. PARK: Okay. Because I am here
15	for on behalf of Guilford Liquor.
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what's your
17	name, sir?
18	MR. PARK: My name is Jay Wong Park.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
20	Mr. Park. I am aware who you are, so thank you
21	for you have made your representation known to
22	the Agency. Thank you. Ms. Phillips?

1	MS. PHILLIPS: I have just been given
2	a limited Power of Attorney, so I have it for my
3	file if you have it for yours.
4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, the Agency
5	I was advised that Mr. Park would be
6	representing the Agency. That's one of the
7	reasons I didn't since I I am not
8	questioning his
9	MS. PHILLIPS: Right. I just wanted
10	to let you know
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: because I
12	was told
13	MS. PHILLIPS: that I had one for
14	the file.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
16	MS. PHILLIPS: So now, I'll introduce
17	myself?
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, ma'am.
19	MS. PHILLIPS: Louise Phillips,
20	Assistant Attorney General for the District of
21	Columbia and with me is Kimberly Berry, also an
22	assistant.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
2	Ms. Phillips and again, Ms. Berry.
3	All right. Are there any preliminary
4	matters in this case?
5	MS. PHILLIPS: My understanding is
6	there are not.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I was told that
8	there was a locked-in OIC. Is that
9	MS. PHILLIPS: Do you have an OIC?
10	MR. PARK: Actually, I
11	MS. PHILLIPS: Okay. Sorry, my
12	problem, my fault.
13	So all right. We have an Offer in
14	Compromise to on charge there only one
15	charge. It's a fine of \$4,000 to be paid within
16	30 days or the license will be suspended
17	indefinitely until the fine is paid. The license
18	shall be suspended for 10 days with six days
19	stayed for one year and four days shall be
20	served. I don't have those dates. Do you have
21	those dates for the Board?
22	MR. PARK: No. We haven't set

1	specific days.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can we I'll
3	take a recess while you guys can discuss the days
4	and come back and let us know.
5	MS. PHILLIPS: Okay.
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So we will
7	recess this case until
8	MS. PHILLIPS: So I'll come back for
9	two.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
11	That's fine.
12	(Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
13	went off the record at 10:03 a.m. and resumed at
14	10:06 a.m.)
15	MS. PHILLIPS: We are going to need 10
16	minutes on this last case that you called. Is
17	that all right?
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We have I
19	don't have another hearing until what I'll do
20	is that we are going to go around back. Do you
21	one of the things that we can do, so Mr. Farmer
22	is here and it appears that he is ready, so let

1	me do that case, so I can dismiss them and then
2	oh, all right.
3	So the
4	MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Call us when you
5	are ready on both.
6	MS. PHILLIPS: Thank you.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: This is what
8	all right. This is what we can do. All right.
9	When you are ready for both cases, because I
10	don't have our next case is at 11:00, so when
11	you are ready on both cases, let us know and we
12	will come back out. Okay?
13	MS. PHILLIPS: I thought it was going
14	to be simple today, Mr. Anderson.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Huh?
16	MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Well, send up a
17	flare.
18	MS. PHILLIPS: All right. A little
19	longer.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
21	(Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
22	went off the record at 10:07 a.m. and resumed at

1	10:32 a.m.)
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
3	Recalling our next case, Case No. 17-CC-00144,
4	Guilford Liquor, License No. 76393.
5	Would the parties, please, approach
6	and identify themselves for the record, please?
7	MR. PARK: Yes, Your Honor. Jay Wong
8	Park on behalf of Guilford Liquor.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
10	again, Mr. Park.
11	MR. PARK: Good morning.
12	MS. PHILLIPS: Louise Phillips,
13	Assistant Attorney General for the District of
14	Columbia and along with Kimberly Berry, also an
15	assistant.
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms.
17	Phillips and Ms. Berry.
18	Are there any preliminary matters in
19	this case?
20	MS. PHILLIPS: Yes, there are.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What are they?
22	MS. PHILLIPS: The parties have agreed

to present an Offer in Compromise that has many 1 2 parts. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 3 So go slowing 4 since I'm taking notes, please. 5 MS. PHILLIPS: There is one charge. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 6 7 MS. PHILLIPS: All right. So the fine 8 for this case is \$4,000 to be paid, I believe he 9 said, today or his license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid. 10 11 And then the license shall be suspended for 10 days with six days stayed for 12 13 one year and four days shall be served. 14 And because there is another day --15 I'm going to do the days once I get through the 16 rest of this. All employees who serve alcoholic beverage in this licensed establishment to 17 18 complete alcohol training within three months of 19 the OIC's date. And in addition, the establishment 20 21 will serve five days, a five day suspension

activated from Case No. 17-CC-00061.

1 Therefore, the days to be served are 2 May 21st through May 29, 2018. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And that covers 3 4 everything? 5 MS. PHILLIPS: That covers everything. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 6 7 Park, it's my understanding that there is an 8 Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise 9 is that for the one charge, there is a \$4,000 fine and the fine will be paid today. 10 11 That there is a -- on Charge 1, that 12 there is a 10 day suspension, six days will be stayed and four days will be served. 13 14 All employees will undergo alcohol 15 training within 90 days of the date of the Board Order that will be issued. 16 17 And that as a result of Charge 1, 18 there are a five day suspension must be served 19 based on Case No. 17-CC-00061. Therefore, there 20 will be a nine day suspension and the nine days 21 of suspension are from May 21st through May 29,

2018.

1 And if the fine is not payable within 2 -- payable today, the license will be suspended, sir. 3 4 Is this your understanding of the 5 Offer in Compromise? 6 MR. PARK: Yes, agree. 7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware 8 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that 9 you are giving up your right to a hearing? Yes, Your Honor. 10 MR. PARK: 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also 12 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, 13 that you are giving up your right to appeal this 14 matter? Yes, Your Honor. 15 MR. PARK: 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are there any 17 questions by any Board Members regarding this 18 Offer in Compromise? Hearing none, I make a motion that 19 this Offer in Compromise of a fine of \$4,000 20 21 payable -- a fine for Charge 1, a fine of \$4,000 22 that the fine will be paid today. If not paid

1 today, the license will be suspended. That there 2 is a -- for that charge, there is a 10-day suspension, six days are stayed and four days are 3 4 served. 5 That all employees will undergo alcohol training within 90 days of the OIC and 6 7 that based on the violation in Charge 1, there is 8 a five day suspension that must be served based 9 on -- because they were triggered by the provisions of Case No. 17-CC-00061 and that the 10 11 days of suspension will be May 21st through May 12 29, 2018. Is there a second? 13 MEMBER SHORT: Second. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has 15 seconded the motion. 16 All those in favor say aye. 17 ALL: Aye. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All those 19 The matter passes 7-0-0. opposed? We will issue a Board Order to 20 21 memorialize this agreement, but although the 22 Board Order probably -- I'm not sure when the

1 Board Order will be written. However, you should 2 pay the fine today and your 90 day triggers for the TIPS training will be 90 days from the date 3 of the written order that you will receive. 4 5 Okay, sir? (No audible answer.) MR. PARK: 6 7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I 8 want to thank the parties today for working this 9 matter out and have a good day. 10 Thank you. MR. PARK: 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. The 12 Board will be in recess until our 11:00 hearing. 13 (Whereupon, the Show Cause (Status) 14 Hearing was concluded at 10:37 a.m.) 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22
