3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The					
4	next case on our calendar is a Fact-Finding					
5	Hearing on Han's Market. Is there anyone here					
6	for Han's Market? All right.					
7	Are you a translator, ma'am?					
8	INTERPRETER: Yes.					
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can you what					
10	language is this?					
11	INTERPRETER: Korean.					
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Korean. Can					
13	you stand, please?					
14	INTERPRETER: Yes.					
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And you raise					
16	your right hand?					
17	Do you swear or affirm that you will					
18	faithfully translate these matters from English					
19	to Korean and from Korean to English?					
20	INTERPRETER: Yes.					
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.					
22	Thank you. I would like her to let identify					

1	herself for the record, please. When she is
2	done.
3	INTERPRETER: I'm sorry, I could not
4	hear.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Oh, I'm sorry.
6	I need her to identify herself for the record.
7	INTERPRETER: Okay.
8	MS. HAN: Yun K Han, Y-U-N K. H-A-N.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
10	Now, you are requesting safekeeping of the
11	license.
12	MS. HAN: Yes.
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And why are you
14	requesting that the license be placed in
15	safekeeping?
16	MS. HAN: I request that I keep it in
17	the safety box.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Why? Why?
19	What's going on with this license?
20	MS. HAN: It's renovation. Currently,
21	we are doing renovation.
22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

1	Now, let me so when was the last time this			
2	establishment was open?			
3	MS. HAN: I cannot remember. Last			
4	year.			
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Last			
6	MS. HAN: I bought it last year.			
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So you bought			
8	the business. Was the business open when you			
9	bought it? When you bought the license, was the			
10	business open?			
11	MS. HAN: Yes.			
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And so why did			
13	you so when did you first put this license in			
14	safekeeping?			
15	MS. HAN: About a month ago.			
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So you were			
17	operating on so you were using the license and			
18	operating the business up to a month ago?			
19	MS. HAN: I almost cannot have			
20	operated.			
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You need to			
22	speak up, ma'am.			

1	INTERPRETER: Okay.				
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What when				
3	did you all right. She bought the business,				
4	right? Did she ever operate once after she				
5	bought the business and bought the license, did				
6	she ever open the store to use it?				
7	MS. HAN: Yes, a while, because it was				
8	old.				
9	INTERPRETER: Okay. In Korean, we can				
10	make				
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You have to				
12	hold your voice.				
13	INTERPRETER: Okay.				
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Lift your voice				
15	up, please.				
16	INTERPRETER: In Korean language, we				
17	can make sentences without subjects.				
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Right.				
19	INTERPRETER: So as Interpreter, I				
20	request that she make sentences with the subject,				
21	because when she said because old I'm not sure				
22	what the subject is.				

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.				
2	INTERPRETER: So				
3	MS. HAN: Okay. Because it was a very				
4	old building. It was a history building. So				
5	because I couldn't operate, we have to close.				
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So what is				
7	going on with the renovation then? What's going				
8	on now?				
9	MS. HAN: Almost finished. We are				
10	going to open in about one or two months from				
11	now.				
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is that are				
13	you all right. Sure, go ahead, Mr. Short.				
14	MEMBER SHORT: So she is saying that				
15	the it's currently closed.				
16	INTERPRETER: Correct.				
17	MEMBER SHORT: Being renovated.				
18	INTERPRETER: Um-hum.				
19	MEMBER SHORT: And that it is going to				
20	be finished in another couple months.				
21	INTERPRETER: Correct.				
22	MEMBER SHORT: So is she going to be				

1	opening in another couple of months?
2	MS. HAN: Yes.
3	MEMBER SHORT: So why do you need
4	safekeeping just for a couple of months?
5	MEMBER ALBERTI: She does.
6	MS. HAN: People told me that if I
7	don't use it, I'm supposed to put it in the safe
8	box, because if not, then it's going to be
9	illegal.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
11	Okay. All right. So you are saying that you
12	should open in one to two months. Are you sure
13	or are you just giving a is that a specific
14	timeline or you just think that it is going to be
15	one to two months, three months, four months? I
16	mean, how are you so sure it's going to be one to
17	two months?
18	MS. HAN: The reason why I thought
19	that way is that I ordered equipment.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ordered what?
21	INTERPRETER: The Interpreter does not
22	recognize the term. Do you mind if I

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Sure.
2	INTERPRETER: verify it?
3	MS. HAN: It's equipment, equipment.
4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay.
5	MS. HAN: I ordered equipment, which
6	is equipment. If I get it early, then I can open
7	the store, but if it gets delayed, then things
8	can be more flexible.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So
10	you bought this license what 2017? What when
11	did you what year did you buy this, purchase
12	this license?
13	MS. HAN: I do not really remember
14	when.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But how about
16	one year ago? Two years ago? Three years ago?
17	MS. HAN: Maybe one year ago.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: One year ago.
19	And she was operating? The business was open
20	until a couple of months ago. Is that correct?
21	MS. HAN: You mean two months ago?
22	No. Let me explain. Okay.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, go ahead.
2	MS. HAN: When I bought the store, I
3	was about to operate the store, so I had all the
4	inspections.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Right.
6	MS. HAN: But the building was so old,
7	so I closed and started to do renovations.
8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. All
9	right. Any other questions by any other Board
10	Members?
11	MEMBER ALBERTI: So can you briefly
12	describe what renovations you are doing?
13	MS. HAN: The roof, the floor,
14	everything, electricity, plumbing, water, water
15	line, everything.
16	MEMBER ALBERTI: Okay. And when did
17	that start?
18	MS. HAN: Last year.
19	MEMBER ALBERTI: Started last year.
20	Okay. And you expect it so and you expect it
21	to be done when?
22	MS. HAN: We have only a final

1	inspection left.
2	MEMBER ALBERTI: I'm sorry, the final
3	inspection?
4	MS. HAN: We have only one final
5	inspection left.
6	MEMBER ALBERTI: Okay. So you expect
7	within six months to be open. Okay.
8	MS. HAN: Yes.
9	MEMBER ALBERTI: Okay. I have no
10	further questions. Thank you.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Any other
12	questions by any of the Board Members?
13	All right. Hearing none, I make a
14	motion that we grant the safekeeping request
15	through September 30, 2018.
16	MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, Mr.
18	Silverstein has seconded the motion.
19	All those in favor say aye.
20	ALL: Aye.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All those
22	opposed? All right. The matter passes 6-0-0.

1	What that means is that as we are
2	giving you until September 30th. However, as
3	soon as your business is ready to open, you can
4	come back to ABRA and then we will give you your
5	license.
6	So if it's the next two months, you
7	can come back here and we'll give you your
8	license and you can open. Okay?
9	MS. HAN: Okay.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good luck.
11	MS. HAN: Thank you.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
13	MS. HAN: Thank you.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
15	MS. HAN: Thank you. Appreciate.
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Sure.
17	(Whereupon, the Fact-Finding Hearing
18	was concluded at 3:49 p.m.)
