## ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

In Board Order No. 2023-067, the Board recognized that ANC 6B and the Applicant had entered into an amended Settlement Agreement (Agreement), dated January 30, 2023, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-446, and approved in Board Order No. 2023-051. The Board noted that upon approval of a settlement agreement between an ANC and the Applicant, all protests filed by groups must be dismissed in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-609(b). Subsequently, the dismissed group filed a motion for reconsideration but failed to present any persuasive reasoning that rendered the decision incorrect or otherwise authorized the Board to contravene a clearly written statute. Consequently, the motion for reconsideration is without bases and must be denied. Accordingly, on this 15th day of February 2023, the

Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
