ORDER VACATING CEASE AND DESIST

On April 24, 2024, the Alcoholic Beverage Cannabis Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2024-231 ordering Hill Country DC, LLC, t/a Hill Country (Respondent), holder of a Retailer's Class Caterer License No. ABRA-089475, to stop selling, serving, or permitting the consumption of alcoholic beverages at the Respondent's establishment until payment of the third-year license fees and any associated fines are received by Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration (ABCA).

On April 26, 2024, the Respondent paid the license fees for the period of 2024 to 2025.

It is hereby **ORDERED** that the **ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST** issued against the Respondent by the Board on April 24, 2024, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), be and hereby is **VACATED**.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1) (applicable to alcohol matters) or 22-C DCMR § 9720 (applicable to medical cannabis matters), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001 (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
