
ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) previously reviewed its records and determined that Piazzmia, LLC, t/a Hopscotch Bar & Grill (Applicant), had failed to renew its Retailer's Class CR License. Specifically, the Board found that the Applicant had failed to renew its license by July 12, 2022, the extension deadline for all Retailer's Class CR licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date. On July 27, 2022, in Board Order No. 2022-550, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order cancelling the license for failing to renew its Retailer's Class CR License. Subsequently, the Applicant filed a request for reinstatement. In its request, the Applicant noted that it had addressed various tax matters that had prevented it from completing the renewal of its license.

ORDER

Therefore, on this 21st day of September 2022, the Board hereby **GRANTS** the motion to reinstate the license. A copy of this Order shall be provided to the Applicant.

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
