ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) previously reviewed its records and determined that Piazzmia, LLC, t/a Hopscotch Bar & Grill (Applicant), had failed to renew its Retailer’s Class CR License. Specifically, the Board found that the Applicant had failed to renew its license by July 12, 2022, the extension deadline for all Retailer’s Class CR licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date. On July 27, 2022, in Board Order No. 2022-550, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order cancelling the license for failing to renew its Retailer’s Class CR License. Subsequently, the Applicant filed a request for reinstatement. In its request, the Applicant noted that it had addressed various tax matters that had prevented it from completing the renewal of its license.

ORDER

Therefore, on this 21st day of September 2022, the Board hereby **GRANTS** the motion to reinstate the license. A copy of this Order shall be provided to the Applicant.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
