3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The
4 next case on our calendar is Case No. 17-CMP-
5 00684, Howard Theatre, License No. 88646.

6 Will the parties, please, approach and
7 identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board
9 Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of
10 Columbia.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
12 Mr. Rivero.

13 I see that there is no one here from
14 Howard Theatre.

15 Do you have any representation to
16 make, Mr. Rivero, regarding whether or not they
17 plan to be here today?

18 MR. RIVERO: I do.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, sir.

20 MR. RIVERO: I was in contact
21 yesterday with, I believe his name is, Chip
22 Allen, one of the partners. I initially got to

1 him by contacting the licensee at a 917 was the
2 area code number that is in the records of the
3 Agency. The number was provided to me by the
4 ABRA Investigator.

5 Having called that number, I spoke
6 with someone whose name I quite didn't catch, but
7 he said you need to be speaking with Mr. Allen
8 and he gave me the number for Mr. Allen, which is
9 a local number (202) number.

10 I spoke to him and I let him know that
11 there was a hearing today, two hearings actually,
12 and that he had been served. Did he receive the
13 notice? He was not familiar with the notice and
14 I told him that Shani Pace, the manager, had been
15 served, according to the service form that is in
16 the case file.

17 And that, you know, these hearings

19 he is aware. He said that he would make it or
20 get someone here. So he is not here and I'm fine
21 with moving along to the next scheduled date in
22 this matter.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you for
2 your representation, Mr. Rivero. And the only
3 reason why I asked that, I'm looking at my
4 calendar and yes, there are two cases and there
5 is also a Fact-Finding Hearing at 10:00, so
6 that's one of the reasons why I was wondering
7 were maybe they running late, since we do have a
8 Fact-Finding Hearing at 10:00 regarding Howard
9 Theatre.

10 MR. RIVERO: Oh, okay.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But so I guess
12 I'm trying to find out should I -- well, what I
13 will do, this case was scheduled for 9:30, so
14 because it's a Show Cause Hearing (Status), we
15 will move on and then this matter is scheduled
16 for a Show Cause Hearing on June 27th at 10:00.

17 MR. RIVERO: Right. Thank you.
