It's my 15 understanding that there is an Offer in 16 Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that 17 there is a fine of \$4,500 payable in 60 days. If 18 the fine is not payable in 60 days, the license 19 will be suspended until the fine has been paid. Is this your understanding of the 20 21 Offer in Compromise? 22 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.
