ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by Miku, LLC, t/a J & D Market (Applicant), to Renew a Retailer's Class B License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on January 2, 2024. On the same day, the Applicant was dismissed for failing to appear at the Roll Call Hearing in Board Order No. 2024-009. Subsequently, the Applicant applied for reinstatements on the basis that the failure to appear was due to the failure to receive the link the virtual hearing. Nevertheless, ABCA's records show that an appropriate invitation was sent to the email address on file with the agency. Therefore, the dismissal for failure to appear lacks good cause and the Applicant must refile their application to maintain licensure.

ORDER

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
