## ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On May 8, 2024, the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class A License No. ABRA-025523 held by Bhuller's Corporation, t/a JJ Mutt Wine & Spirits (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to renew its license by March 31, 2024, the deadline for all Retailer's Class A licenses. *See* Board Order No. 2024-367.

On May 8, 2024, Victoria Wheatly, on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class A License No. ABRA-025523. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that all issues preventing the Petitioner from renew its license have been resolved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner submits the renewal application and pays the license fees.

Accordingly, it is this 15th day of May 2024, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on May 8, 2024, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that its Retailer's Class A License No. ABRA-025523 be **REINSTATED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Petitioner submit the renewal application and pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1) (applicable to alcohol matters) or 22-C DCMR § 9720 (applicable to medical cannabis matters), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001 (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
