**ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF THE GROUP OF FIVE INDIVIDUALS  
OR MORE INDIVIDUALS' PROTEST**

---

The Application filed by Jvlhc, LLC, t/a Jimmy Valentine's Lonely Hearts Club (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on December 9, 2019 and a Protest Status Hearing on November 5, 2020.

On December 9, 2019, the Board's agent advised the Group of Five or More Individuals at the Roll Call Hearing that five (5) individuals must appear at the Protest Status Hearing in order to be granted standing as A Group of Five or More Individuals. The Group of Five or More Individuals was originally granted conditional standing at the Roll Call Hearing.

On November 5, 2020, the Board dismissed the Protest of the Group of Five or More Individuals because the Group of Five or More Individuals failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing, in accordance with the Title 23 of the District Columbia Municipal Regulations § 1603.3. The Group of Five or More Individuals may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

### **ORDER**

The Board does hereby this 5th day of November 2020, **DISMISS** the Protest of the Group of Five or More Individuals. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and James Butler, on behalf of the Group of Five or More Individuals.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E StTeet, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
