MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of Jimmy Valentine's Lonely Hearts Club please come forward, the parties in the matter of Jimmy Valentine's Lonely Hearts Club?

This is Case \#19-PRO-00149, JVLE, LLC, 1103 Bladensburg Road NE, License \#ABRA-076330. This is a Retailer Class CT License Renewal

The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet, residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety and real property values.

My name is Laverne Fletcher conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Excuse me, sir, can you do me a big favor and close that door in the back? Thank you very much. That one, thank you.

MR. BUTLER: Good morning. I'm James Butler, J-A-M-E-S B-U-T-L-E-R, one of the protestants here. It appears that the applicant has not shown up.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Butler. So, Mr. Butler, you're part of a group of six. Are you the designated representative for the
group?
MR. BUTLER: I am.
MS. FLETCHER: We will accept the representation today. If you would have the -there are five other individuals in your -actually, five other individuals in your group. We'll need that designation in writing.

I didn't see it in the protest letter, but --

MR. BUTLER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: -- it's okay because you're going to say --

MR. BUTLER: We will memorialize that for you, right.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, that's fine. And you can present that at any time. Just email it to -- you could email it even to my email address that's on that --

MR. BUTLER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: There's a card. I have a card on the table.

MR. BUTLER: Great.
MS. FLETCHER: You can send it to me and $I$ will put it in the file.

With respect to your group of six, I'm
granting conditional standing to your group. That means that at the upcoming status hearing, if there will be one -- we don't know yet, but if there will be one, because I'm not going to schedule any dates today because the applicant is not here.

But if at some point in the future he is granted reinstatement, I'm going to dismiss the application in a minute -- at some point, if he's granted a reinstatement, there's going to be a status hearing.

If there is one, at least four more people that are not here today need to appear inperson. The Board needs to see at least five faces. So you're here today. You count as one. We would need to see four more people from that group.

And just for the record, there were two names on your protest letter that are not legible. So I can't address those two. But for the names that $I$ could read, there are six of you, which is sufficient.

MR. BUTLER: That's correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so I'm granting conditional standing to six. The applicant is
not present. The application is dismissed.
Mr. Butler, did you put your contact information on this sheet already?

MR. BUTLER: I have not, but I will do so now.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, good because what's going to happen, the Board's going to dismiss the application because they're not present, and you'll be kept informed.

You'll receive a copy of the order as well dismissing the applicant. The applicant will have at least ten days to seek reinstatement of the application. If they do, you'll be kept informed of that.

If they do, you'll hear from me because I'll need to contact you to set a date for mediation. As of this moment, there is no pending application for a License Renewal because the applicant is not present.

MR. BUTLER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: If you have any other questions, give me a call. Got my card.

MR. BUTLER: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Do you have any today? Any questions?

MR. BUTLER: I do not.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very much.

MR. BUTLER: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for coming. The roll call hearing is concluded.
