CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon, everyone. We're back on the record. Welcome to the afternoon session of the ABC Board.

My name is Donovan Anderson. I'm Chairman of the Board. We're joined this afternoon by Mr. James Short, Mr. Bobby Cato, Ms. Rafi Crockett, Ms. Jeni Hansen, Mr. Edward Grandis. The Board has six members in attendance today and that constitutes a quorum.

We have two hearings on our afternoon calendar, a fact finding hearing and a protest hearing. I know that this hearing was supposed to started at 1:30. The first hearing, we have the fact finding hearing, that was supposed to start at 1:30. It's now 2:30.

The protest hearing, that is the participants for the protest, they're sitting in the waiting room. That hearing was supposed to start at 2:30.
