ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF PROTESTS

The Application filed by DK, Corporation, t/a Joe Caplan Liquors (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's Class A License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on July 12, 2021.

On July 12, 2021, the Board dismissed the Protests of Sara Gragert Group and Michael Hung Group because neither Group appeared at the Roll Call Hearing.

Additionally, the Board dismissed the Protest of John Webster and David Harris because they failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing and did not claim to be abutting property owners or to be part of a Group of Five or More Individuals.

The Sara Gragert Group, the Michael Hung Group, and John Webster and David Harris may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

ORDER

The Board does hereby this 15th day of July 2021, **DISMISS** the Protests of Sara Gragert Group, Michael Hung Group, and John Webster and David Harris.

The Board **ADVISES** the Parties that the protest of Elaine Gin Group remains. The Protest Status Hearing is set for August 18, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. and the Protest Hearing is set for September 30, 2021 at 3:30 p.m.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
