3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4 on our Show Cause Hearing (Status) Calendar is
5 Case No. 18-CMP-00093, Justin's Café, License No.
6 83690.

7 Would the parties, please, approach
8 and identify themselves for the record, please?

9 MR. ADAMS: Good morning, Mr.
10 Chairman. Walter Adams representing the District
11 of Columbia.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Adams.

13 MS. KAYS: I'm Allison Kays, the
14 general manager of Justin's Café.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Kays, good
16 morning. Do you have a letter of representation?

17 MS. KAYS: I do.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Could we have
19 that, please?

20 MS. KAYS: Sure.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Mr.
22 Adams, are there any preliminary matters in this

1 case?

2 MR. ADAMS: There is a preliminary
3 matter, Mr. Chairman. The parties have discussed
4 this case involving, it looks like there is, two
5 charges here. We are willing to -- the parties
6 have agreed to resolve the case for a fine in the
7 amount of \$1,500 to be paid today. If the
8 licensee fails to pay the fine today, the license
9 shall be suspended indefinitely until such time
10 the fine is paid.

11 How this breaks down, Mr. Chairman, is
12 that for Charge 1, for failure to follow the
13 terms of the Board-approved license, that they
14 will pay -- that's where the fine will be applied
15 of the \$1,500 to be paid today.

16 And for Charge 2, which is the
17 settlement agreement charge, for that charge, we
18 propose that the Board dismiss that charge.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms.
20 Kays, it's my understanding there is an Offer in
21 Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that
22 there is a fine of \$1,500 payable today. If the

1 fine is not payable today, the license will be
2 suspended until the fine has been paid.

3 Charge 2 has been dismissed.

4 Is this your understanding of the
5 Offer in Compromise?

6 MS. KAYS: Yes.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
8 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that
9 you are giving up your right to a hearing?

10 MS. KAYS: Yes.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You're also
12 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,
13 you are giving up your right to appeal this
14 matter?

15 MS. KAYS: Yes.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. With
17 that said, I make a motion that the Offer in
18 Compromise of a fine of \$1,500 payable today, if
19 the fine is not payable today, the license will
20 be suspended until the fine has been paid and
21 that Charge 2 will be dismissed.

22 Is there a second?

1 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
3 seconded the motion.

4 All those in favor say aye.

5 ALL: Aye.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
7 The matter passes 6-0-0.

8 Thank you very much. I'll have you
9 sign-off on this. Once you sign this document,
10 then you can go pay the fine. All right. Thank
11 you.

12 MS. KAYS: Thank you.

13 (Whereupon, the Show Cause (Status)
14 Hearing was concluded at 10:00 a.m.)
