The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

4	next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-251-
5	00021, Kabin, License No. 91276.
6	Will the parties, please, approach and
7	identify themselves for the record, please?
8	MR. ADAMS: Good morning, Mr.
9	Chairman, Members of the Board. Walter Adams
10	Representing the District.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
12	again, Mr. Adams.
13	MS. YOHANNES: Good morning. Sidon
14	Yohannes on behalf of the licensee.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
16	Ms. Yohannes.
17	Mr. Adams, are there any preliminary
18	matters in this case?
19	MR. ADAMS: There is a preliminary
20	matter. There are preliminary matters in this
21	case. The parties have discussed this case and
22	are able to make an Offer in Compromise proposal.

To settle this case, Mr. Chairman, we are proposing a fine of \$1,500 to be paid within 30 days. If the licensee fails to make that payment within the 30-day period, the license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

How this breaks down, Mr. Chairman, is that the parties are proposing that we dismiss Charge 1 for disorderly conduct.

For Charge 2, for failure to comply with terms of the security plan, that's where we are asking for the application of the \$1,500 fine to be paid within 30 days.

And Charge 3, which is also a security plan violation, the parties are proposing dismissal of that charge.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms
Yohannes, it's my understanding that there is an
Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise
is that Charge 1 will be dismissed. Charge 2,
there is a fine of \$1,500 payable in 30 days. If
the fine is not payable in 30 days, the license
will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

And for Charge 3, that is also dismissed. 1 2 Is this your understanding of the Offer in Compromise? 3 4 MS. YOHANNES: Yes. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client 5 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, 6 that they are giving up their right to a hearing? 7 8 MS. YOHANNES: Yes. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And are they also aware that by accepting an Offer in 10 Compromise, that they are giving up their right 11 12 to appeal this matter? 13 MS. YOHANNES: Yes. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said, I make a motion that the Offer in Compromise of a 15 16 dismissal of Charge 1, a \$1,500 fine for Charge 2 17 payable in 30 days. If the fine -- if the \$1,500 18 fine is not payable in 30 days, the license will 19 be suspended. And Charge 3 will be dismissed. 20 Is there a second? 21 MEMBER SHORT: Second. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has 22
