3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The  
4 next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-251-  
5 00021, Kabin, License No. 91276.

6 Will the parties, please, approach and  
7 identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MR. ADAMS: Good morning, Mr.  
9 Chairman, Members of the Board. Walter Adams  
10 Representing the District.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning  
12 again, Mr. Adams.

13 MS. YOHANNES: Good morning. Sidon  
14 Yohannes on behalf of the licensee.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,  
16 Ms. Yohannes.

17 Mr. Adams, are there any preliminary  
18 matters in this case?

19 MR. ADAMS: There is a preliminary  
20 matter. There are preliminary matters in this  
21 case. The parties have discussed this case and  
22 are able to make an Offer in Compromise proposal.

1 To settle this case, Mr. Chairman, we are  
2 proposing a fine of \$1,500 to be paid within 30  
3 days. If the licensee fails to make that payment  
4 within the 30-day period, the license will be  
5 suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

6 How this breaks down, Mr. Chairman, is  
7 that the parties are proposing that we dismiss  
8 Charge 1 for disorderly conduct.

9 For Charge 2, for failure to comply  
10 with terms of the security plan, that's where we  
11 are asking for the application of the \$1,500 fine  
12 to be paid within 30 days.

13 And Charge 3, which is also a security  
14 plan violation, the parties are proposing  
15 dismissal of that charge.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms.  
17 Yohannes, it's my understanding that there is an  
18 Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise  
19 is that Charge 1 will be dismissed. Charge 2,  
20 there is a fine of \$1,500 payable in 30 days. If  
21 the fine is not payable in 30 days, the license  
22 will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

1 And for Charge 3, that is also dismissed.

2 Is this your understanding of the  
3 Offer in Compromise?

4 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client  
6 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,  
7 that they are giving up their right to a hearing?

8 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And are they  
10 also aware that by accepting an Offer in  
11 Compromise, that they are giving up their right  
12 to appeal this matter?

13 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said,  
15 I make a motion that the Offer in Compromise of a  
16 dismissal of Charge 1, a \$1,500 fine for Charge 2  
17 payable in 30 days. If the fine -- if the \$1,500  
18 fine is not payable in 30 days, the license will  
19 be suspended. And Charge 3 will be dismissed.

20 Is there a second?

21 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has

1 seconded the motion.

2 All those in favor say aye.

3 ALL: Aye.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All those  
5 opposed? The matter passes 6-0-0.

6 The Board will be issuing a Board  
7 Order on this matter. Thank you very much.

8 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.

9 (Whereupon, the Show Cause (Status)  
10 Hearing was concluded at 9:56 a.m.)
