3 MEMBER ANDERSON: The next case on our
4 calendar is case number 19-CMP-00119, Karma,
5 license number 101682. Will the parties please
6 approach and identify themselves for the record,
7 please?

8 MR. FACCI: Good morning. Jason Facci
9 on behalf of the District of Columbia.

10 MEMBER ANDERSON: Mr. Facci.

11 MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on behalf
12 of the licensee.

13 MEMBER ANDERSON: Ms. Yohannes. Are
14 there any preliminary matters in this case?

15 MR. FACCI: Yes, Mr. Chairman. We do
16 have an offer in compromise.

17 MEMBER ANDERSON: And what is that,
18 please?

19 MR. FACCI: With respect to charge 1,
20 a \$1,500 fine to be paid within 30 days or the
21 license shall be suspended indefinitely until the
22 fine is paid. And with respect to Charge 2, a
23 \$1,500 fine within 30 days or the license shall
24 be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

25 MEMBER ANDERSON: Thank you. Ms.

1 Yohannes, it's my understanding that there is an
2 offer in compromise. And the offer in compromise
3 for charge 1 is a \$1,500 fine payable within 30
4 days.

5 And also for charge 2, there is a
6 \$1,500 fine payable in 30 days. If the fines are
7 not paid in 30 days, the license will be
8 suspended until the fine has been paid.

9 Is this then your client's
10 understanding of the offer in compromise?

11 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, it is.

12 MEMBER ANDERSON: Is your client aware
13 that by accepting the offer in compromise that
14 they're giving up their right to a hearing?

15 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

16 MEMBER ANDERSON: And is your client
17 also aware that by accepting an offer in
18 compromise that they're giving up their right to
19 appeal this matter?

20 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

21 MEMBER ANDERSON: With that said, I
22 make a motion that the offer in compromise be
23 accepted. For charge 1, there is a fine of
24 \$1,500 payable within 30 days.

25 For charge 2, there is also a \$1,500

1 fine payable within 30 days. If the license --
2 if the fines have not been paid within 30 days,
3 the license will be suspended until the fine has
4 been paid. Is there a second?

5 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

6 MEMBER ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
7 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
8 aye.

9 (Chorus of ayes)

10 MEMBER ANDERSON: Those opposed? The
11 matter passes 6-0-0. We'll have you sign off on
12 it.
