## ORDER DENYING PROTESTANT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

On this 4th day of March 2020, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board **DENIES** Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 1B's motion to dismiss Kiss LLC, t/a Kiss Tavern, (Applicant) for failing to appear at the scheduled mediation. The Board does not find that the Applicant unreasonably refused to appear at mediation under District of Columbia Official Code § 25-445 where the Applicant's representative was merely late, was in communication with ABRA staff on the day of the mediation, counsel attempted to appear at the mediation, and there is no showing that the Applicant has engaged in a pattern of failing to appear at scheduled hearings. Under 23 DCMR § 1719.1, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, under section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration under 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
