3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

4 Good morning, everyone. I would like to welcome
5 you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the
6 District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control
7 Board. Please know that today's hearings will be
8 conducted in accordance with D.C. Official Code
9 Section 2-574 of the Open Meetings Act.

10 Today is August 8, 2018. I would like
11 to introduce Members of the Board with us today.
12 To my far right is Mr. Donald Isaac, Sr., to his
13 left is Mr. Bobby Cato. To my far left is Ms.
14 Rema Wahabzadah. To her right is Mr. Mike
15 Silverstein and to my immediate left is Mr. James
16 Short. My name is Donovan Anderson, I'm the
17 Chairman of the Board and we do have a quorum
18 today.

19 I would like to mention two things
20 before we get started. First of all, if you have
21 any electronic devices, pagers, cell phones or
22 such, please, make certain that they are turned

1 off to avoid any interruption of the proceedings.

2 Secondly, there is a piece of paper on
3 each table. When you come forward as your case
4 is called, please, take a seat at the table and,
5 please, sign-in. This is to ensure the correct
6 spelling of your name for the record.

7 I would note that the approximate time
8 is 9:52. I apologize for not taking the Bench
9 promptly at 9:30. I know you were here. I
10 appreciate the fact that you were prompt and so I
11 apologize on behalf of the Board that we were
12 delayed in coming out here.

13 Anyway, let's start off. We will
14 start off with our Show Cause Hearing (Status)
15 Calendar. The first case on our Show Cause
16 Hearing (Status) Calendar is Case No. 18-AUD-
17 00027, La Dulce Noche, License No. 92426.

18 Will the parties, please, approach and
19 identify themselves for the record, please?

20 MR. ADAMS: Good morning, Mr.
21 Chairman. Walter Adams representing the District
22 of Columbia.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
2 Mr. Adams.

3 MR. SOLLOSO: Good morning. My name
4 is Jose Solloso, the owner of the business.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
6 Mr., you said, Solloso?

7 MR. SOLLOSO: Yes, sir.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

11 Are there any preliminary matters in
12 this case?

13 MR. ADAMS: Mr. Chairman, despite
14 discussions, there are no preliminary matters in
15 this case.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
17 This matter then is scheduled for a Show Cause
18 Hearing on September 12th at 3:30 p.m.

19 Mr. Solloso, please, forgive me, I'm
20 not trying to be any way discriminatory, but for
21 the hearing, do you need a translator, sir?

22 MR. SOLLOSO: No, not really.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. I wanted
2 to make sure. All right.

3 Then this matter then is scheduled for
4 a Show Cause Hearing on September 12th at 3:30.
5 And at that hearing you can, since you are
6 contesting this case, you will bring your
7 witnesses and you will argue the case on
8 September 12th. Okay?

9 MR. SOLLOSO: All right.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So I'll see you
11 at 3:30. Thank you very much.

12 MR. ADAMS: Take care, sir.
