ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On September 25, 2019, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License ABRA-026051 held by La Loma, Inc., t/a La Loma (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to pay the safekeeping fee for its license. *See* Board Order No. 2019-660.

On January 3, 2020, Samuel Fuentes, on behalf of the Petitioner sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License ABRA-026051. In support of his Request for Reinstatement, Mr. Fuentes stated he sold his property and he intends to transfer the license to the new owner once it is reinstated.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner pays the required fees.

Accordingly, it is this 8th day of January, 2020, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against La Loma, Inc., t/a La Loma, by the Board on September 25, 2019, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Retailer's Class CR License ABRA-026051 be REINSTATED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
