3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4 on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-00115,
5 Laliguras Indian & Napali Bistro, License No.
6 95042.

7 Will the parties, please, approach and
8 identify themselves for the record, please?

9 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board
10 Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of
11 Columbia.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
13 again, Mr. Rivero.

14 MR. TAMANG: Good morning, Board
15 Member. I am Dawa Tamang from Laliguras Indian &
16 Napali Bistro.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
18 Mr. Tamang. Okay. Good morning.

19 All right. Are there any preliminary
20 matters in this case?

21 MR. RIVERO: Yes, there are. Board
22 Members, the parties have an Offer in Compromise

1 to present, at this time. And that offer is a
2 fine of \$2,000 payable immediately.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And if it's not
4 paid, the license will be suspended until paid.
5 All right. Fine.

6 MR. RIVERO: As it happens, the
7 licensee has payment today.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. All
9 right. Mr. Tamang, it's my understanding that
10 there is an Offer in Compromise and the Offer in
11 Compromise is that there is a fine of \$2,000
12 payable today. If the license -- if the fine is
13 not payable today, the license will be suspended
14 until payment has been made.

15 Is this your understanding, sir, of
16 the Offer in Compromise?

17 MR. TAMANG: Yes, sir, I want to pay.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Sure. Are you
19 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,
20 that you are giving up your right to a hearing?

21 MR. TAMANG: Yes, sir.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That you are

1 also giving up your right to appeal this matter?

2 MR. TAMANG: Yes.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So
4 with this said, I then make a motion that the
5 Offer in Compromise of a fine of \$2,000 payable
6 today, if the fine is not payable today, the
7 license will be suspended. Is there a second?

8 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
10 seconded the motion.

11 All those in favor say aye.

12 ALL: Aye.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
14 The matter passes 5-0-0.

15 So I'll give you this paperwork so you
16 can go and pay the fine. Thank you.

17 MR. RIVERO: Thank you.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
