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**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND  
REINSTATING LICENSE**

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On March 6, 2019, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CT License ABRA-110740 held by Neighbour, Inc., t/a Laos In Town (Petitioner), because the Petitioner had ceased operations. *See* Board Order No. 2019-115.

On March 7, 2019, Wongniwat Ongsangkoon, on behalf of the Petitioner sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CT License ABRA-110740. In support of his Request for Reinstatement, Mr. Ongsangkoon stated that they briefly suspended operations for renovations and he is planning to resume operations on April, 2019.

Furthermore, Mr. Ongsangkoon stated that the written notice mailed by the Licensing Division was mailed to the Petitioner's former representative.


The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

Accordingly, it is this 13th day of March, 2019, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against Neighbour, Inc., t/a Laos In Town, by the Board on March 6, 2019, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Retailer's Class CT License ABRA-110740 be **REINSTATED**.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
