AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of Lavagna, please, come forward? This is Case No. 19-PRO-00024, Good Food, LLC, 539 8th Street, S.E., License No. ABRA-086529. This is a Retail Class CR License renewal.

The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent.

Introductions beginning with the applicant, please?

Sir, if you could state your name and spell it for the record?

MR. CHEUNG: Sure. My name is Stephen Cheung and it's spelled S-T-E-P-H-E-N last name is Cheung, C-H-E-U-N-G.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much. Present on behalf of ANC-6B?

MR. JAYARAMAN: Good morning, Ms. Fletcher. My name is Chander Jayaraman. To

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
4 Jayaraman. I always have a little trouble.

5 MR. JAYARAMAN: It's real easy
6 Jayaraman.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
8 Is there a settlement agreement on the
9 table, at this point?

10 MR. JAYARAMAN: We have resolved the
11 issue, any and all and any outstanding issues.
12 What we did last Thursday, we was at the ABC
13 Committee, voted to officially withdraw the
14 protest.

15 So we do not meet until tomorrow, so
16 we expect to resolve that, but I -- but we wanted
17 to appear to retain our rights.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
19 Is that accurate, Mr. Cheung?

20 MR. CHEUNG: Yes.

21 AGENT FLETCHER: And so, Mr.
22 Jayaraman, the ANC is going to be withdrawing the

1 protest?

2 MR. JAYARAMAN: Yes, ma'am.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. And so there
4 is -- you don't see any need to schedule any
5 hearings?

6 MR. JAYARAMAN: I don't believe so.
7 I mean, we have got it resolved and we didn't
8 have it last month, but we have since then.

9 AGENT FLETCHER: Um-hum.

10 MR. JAYARAMAN: So if you want to
11 schedule a time, we can do that for mediation.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: Um-hum.

13 MR. JAYARAMAN: If it's -- if that's
14 the appropriate course given the regulations.

15 AGENT FLETCHER: Um-hum.

16 MR. JAYARAMAN: However, from our
17 view, we do not expect any alternate course that
18 we will be taking.

19 AGENT FLETCHER: I'll tell you what
20 I'll do then. Just for the record, I'll give you
21 a date for a Status and a Protest Hearing, but
22 I'm not going to set a date for mediation.

1 MR. JAYARAMAN: Okay.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: I'll give you the
3 date scheduled for the Status Hearing and the
4 Protest Hearing and they will be canceled once
5 you submit the withdrawal of the protest.

6 MR. JAYARAMAN: Okay.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: The date for the
8 Status Hearing is June 12. June 12, 2019 at
9 9:30.

10 The Protest Hearing is set for July
11 17. July 17 at 4:30. That's for the Protest
12 Hearing.

13 If the withdrawal doesn't work out,
14 then we will set a date for the mediation.

15 MR. JAYARAMAN: Fair enough.

16 AGENT FLETCHER: Any questions at all?

17 MR. JAYARAMAN: No.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank
19 you for coming. The Roll Call Hearing is
20 concluded.

21 MR. CHEUNG: Thank you.

22 MR. JAYARAMAN: Thank you very much.
