ORDER DENYING THE PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

On November 15, 2017, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2017-573 cancelling Precious Pies and Catering LLC, t/a Layla Lounge (Petitioner), License No. ABRA-097367.

The Board cancelled the license because the Petitioner failed to pay the second year license fees for its license by September 30, 2017, the deadline for all Retailer's CT licenses, despite being notified by ABRA of the payment date.

On January 31, 2018, Christopher Lafon, Esq., on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CT License No. ABRA-097367. The deadline to seek the Request for Reinstatement was November 30, 2017, ten (10) days from the date of Order No. 2017-573. However, the Petitioner's Request for Reinstatement was received by the Alcoholic

Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) on February 14, 2018; therefore, its request is considered untimely filed.


The Board finds that the Petitioner's Request for Reinstatement was untimely filed.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
