3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The  
4 next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-AUD-  
5 00108, LeDesales, License No. 60754.

6 Will the parties, please, approach and  
7 identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board  
9 Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of  
10 Columbia.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,  
12 Mr. Rivero.

13 MR. BOSWORTH: Good morning, Geoff  
14 Bosworth on behalf of Cafe Europa t/a LeDesales.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is  
16 your relationship with the establishment, sir?

17 MR. BOSWORTH: I'm the general  
18 manager.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do you have a  
20 Letter of Authorization? Can I have a copy of  
21 that, please, sir? You can give that to her,  
22 sir. Okay.

1           Mr. Rivero, are there any preliminary  
2 matters in this case?

3           MR. RIVERO: Yes, Board Members, the  
4 parties have an Offer in Compromise to present,  
5 at this time. That offer consists of a fine of  
6 \$1,250 payable in 30 days. If the fine is not  
7 payable in 30 days, the license will be suspended  
8 until payment is received.

9           CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Thank  
10 you, Mr. Rivero. Just as an FYI, do you know  
11 whether or not -- where is this establishment  
12 with the outstanding submission of quarterly  
13 statements?

14           MR. RIVERO: It was filed.

15           CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Thank  
16 you, sir.

17           All right. Mr. Bosworth, it is my  
18 understanding that there is an Offer in  
19 Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that  
20 there is a fine of \$1,250 payable within 30 days.  
21 If the fine is not payable within 30 days, the  
22 license will be suspended until the fine has been

1 paid.

2 Is this your understanding, sir, of  
3 the Offer in Compromise?

4 MR. BOSWORTH: Yes, it is.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware  
6 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that  
7 you are giving up your right to a hearing?

8 MR. BOSWORTH: Yes.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also  
10 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,  
11 that you are giving up your right to appeal this  
12 matter?

13 MR. BOSWORTH: Yes.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said,  
15 I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise  
16 of a fine of \$1,250 payable within 30 days be  
17 accepted. If the fine is not payable within 30  
18 days, the license will be suspended until the  
19 fine has been paid. Is there a second?

20 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has  
22 seconded the motion.

1 All those in favor say aye.

2 ALL: Aye.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?

4 The matter passes 6-0-0. I'll have you sign-off  
5 on this paperwork, sir.

6 MR. BOSWORTH: Okay. Thank you.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
