4 on our calendar is Case No. 18-PRO-00029, Lee's
5 Liquor, License No. 95751.

6 Will the parties, please, approach and
7 identify themselves for Lee's Liquor? This is
8 the matter that was protested by ANC-7B. Since
9 there are no parties here, it's 9:48 and the
10 hearing was scheduled for 10:00 and -- are you
11 here for Lee's Liquor? No? All right.

12 Then neither the licensee or the
13 protestant are here, I make a motion that we
14 dismiss this protest. Is there a second?

15 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
17 seconded the motion.

18 All those --

19 MEMBER ALBERTI: What about -- well,
20 okay, go ahead.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What about
22 what? What was the question?

1 MEMBER ALBERTI: I'll vote for that,
2 but I -- if the owner doesn't show up, then the
3 application gets dismissed.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I thought I
5 said both. Oh.

6 MEMBER ALBERTI: So I'm not sure that
7 that's clear. I wasn't clear --

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

9 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- what the motion
10 really was.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Then I make a
12 motion that neither the protestant nor the
13 applicant is here, so, therefore, I make a motion
14 that we dismiss the renewal application and that
15 we dismiss the protest. Is there a second?

16 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
18 seconded the motion.

19 All those in favor say aye.

20 ALL: Aye.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All those
22 opposed? The matter passes 5-0-0.

1 And what this means is that the Agency
2 will issue an order today dismissing the renewal
3 application and dismissing the protest and both
4 sides will have 10 days to provide us good cause
5 why neither party was here today.
