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**ORDER CANCELLING EXPIRED TEMPORARY OPERATOR’S RETAIL PERMIT**

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On September 18, 2024, the Board approved a request filed by TZSTZ Partners, LLC, t/a Legacy HiFi (Applicant) for a Temporary Operator’s Retail Permit (TORP) in accordance with 23 D.C. Municipal Regulations (DCMR) § 201. (*See* Board Order No. 2024-637).

Per 23 DCMR § 201.5, “Notwithstanding § 201.4, no temporary operating retail permit shall be valid for longer than ninety (90) calendar days unless extended by the Board for good cause.” The Applicant’s TORP permit expired on December 17, 2024, and no request for a TORP’s extension has been submitted.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 15th day of January 2025, that TZSTZ Partners, LLC’s TORP is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant.

Pursuant to 23 DCMR §9723.1 (2003) any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
