The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

4	next case is Case No. 18-CMP-00169, Letena,
5	License No. 104754.
6	Would the parties, please, approach
7	and identify themselves for the record?
8	MS. SCHMIDT: Good morning. Amy
9	Schmidt, Assistant Attorney General, on behalf of
10	the District of Columbia.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
12	Ms. Schmidt, again.
13	MS. EZINEH: Yamroi Ezineh, Letena.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, your
15	last name, ma'am?
16	MS. EZINEH: Yamroi Ezineh.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yamroi Ezineh?
18	MS. EZINEH: Ezineh.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ezineh. All
20	right. Good morning.
21	Are there any preliminary matters for
22	this case?

MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, there is a 1 2 preliminary matter. In this case, the Government -- the parties are asking that a written warning 3 be issued in this case. This is because unlike 4 5 recent Board cases, there was no evidence that any alcohol was consumed and the licensee did 6 7 have a DDOT permit. 8 And she said she made a good faith 9 effort to try to see what she needed. And even though she didn't get the endorsement, she has 10 not had her chairs out there. She has not 11 12 operated the cafe since -- once she got this 13 warning. She said she got this a week later 14 after she had gone to see ABRA. Therefore, we are asking for a written 15 16 warning and the condition that no chairs be 17 allowed outside and nothing served outside until 18 the administrative process is completed with 19 ABRA. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is that a part 21 of the OIC? 22 MS. SCHMIDT: Yes.


1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. All					
2	right. It's my understanding, ma'am, there is an					
3	Offer in Compromise. The Offer in Compromise is					
4	that a written warning will be issued. And that					
5	you will not basically, I'm sorry, I just want					
6	to be clear again.					
7	MS. SCHMIDT: No chairs and tables					
8	outside, not serve anything outside, especially					
9	alcohol.					
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That there will					
11	be no chairs, no tables and alcohol will not be					
12	served on this sidewalk cafe until you have been					
13	approved by this Agency to do that.					
14	Is that your understanding of the					
15	Offer in Compromise?					
16	MS. EZINEH: Right, yes.					
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware					
18	that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that					
19	you are giving up your right to a hearing?					
20	MS. EZINEH: (No audible answer.)					
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also					
22	aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,					

1	that you are giving up your right to appeal this
2	matter?
3	MS. EZINEH: (No audible answer.)
4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You have to say
5	yes.
6	MS. EZINEH: Yes, I do.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
8	With that said, I then make a motion that the
9	Offer in Compromise, that a written warning will
10	be issued and that the it's clear to the
11	licensee that the sidewalk cafe cannot be
12	there will be no chairs or tables on the sidewalk
13	cafe until she has the licensee has been
14	approved by this Agency to operate. Basically,
15	until they receive the endorsement. Is there a
16	second?
17	MEMBER SHORT: Second.
18	MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short and
20	Mr. Silverstein have seconded the motion.
21	All those in favor say aye.
22	ALL: Aye.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
2	The matter passes 6-0-0.
3	Thank you. You can sign-off. Hold
4	on, ma'am. You can sign-off on this paperwork
5	and then the matter all right.
6	All right. Then the Board is in
7	recess until our 1:30 hearing. All right. Thank
8	you.
