3	MR. WITT: So I did want to move	
4	forward with the one that was slated for Parcel B	
5	at 100 Potomac Avenue.	
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay.	
7	MR. WITT: That was a second one that	
8	I had applied for on April the 6th.	
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So that was	
10	MR. WITT: That was a one-day event	
11	for one-time only. I would like to move forward	
12	with that one, since it is a different address	
13	and location.	
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So this is the	
15	one for which one is this? I'm sorry.	
16	MR. WITT: It should be for Parcel B	
17	at 100 Potomac Avenue.	
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay.	
19	MR. WITT: I believe it was the second	
20	one that was on the agenda today.	
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.	
22	MEMBER SHORT: Yes.	

	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So all right.
2	This is just a one-time event?
3	MR. WITT: Yes, sir. It's a one-time
4	event. This is a catering event for our main
5	partner, Audi. It is their employee picnic. We
6	actually hosted this event in this space last
7	year. Originally, we had a summer garden permit
8	that covered this area. That was revoked after
9	our extension of our Certificate of Occupancy due
10	to not having permanent bathroom structures,
11	according to DCRA.
12	So this year, I would like to submit
13	a one-day permit for the catering event.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, I am
15	laughing for a different reason that Mr. Short,
16	you heard DCRA revoked a permit for someone that
17	had one. I just you don't have to respond.
18	MR. WITT: I'm sorry, they would not
19	grant us a Certificate of Occupancy.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: It's an inside
21	joke.
22	MR. WITT: Okay.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 1 It has nothing 2 to do with you, that's why I'm picking on my Board Member, Mr. Short. 3 4 MEMBER SHORT: I'm always coming up 5 short with them. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, this is 6 7 regarding DCRA. All right. So, Mr. Puente, do 8 you have any questions about this event that you 9 want to raise here? INVESTIGATOR PUENTE: 10 Just a few. went out to the site last week. 11 I took 12 photographs. You guys kind of have those steel 13 barricades placed around the whole outline, I 14 guess, of the grass? 15 MR. WITT: Correct. That's something 16 that we keep in place every game day. We will 17 add an additional barrier around this specific 18 event that is happening inside of the gated area. 19 And I kind of brought a small map here. 20 The blue space would be where we are 21 potentially having this event. The black around that would be the fence barrier that we would 22

is what we currently have blocked off. So we would block off this event inside of that space there. MEMBER SHORT: Can I see that, Mr. Chair? MR. WITT: Yes, we will have CSC and potentially APEX Security as well. There will be one entry/exit point to the event. They will be positioned there and then we will have a couple people roaming throughout the gated area inside as well. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hold on. Do we have a copy of that, the map that you are talking about? MR. WITT: I brought a couple copies. It was requested that I bring a few. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. MEMBER SHORT: Yes. We will check IDs at the point of 5 sale inside the location. 6 INVESTIGATOR PUENTE: Will patrons be 7 8 given wristbands or some kind of identification 9 showing that they are 21? MR. WITT: There is not currently a 10 plan in place for that, but we can certainly 11 12 institute it if you would like. We generally 13 check the ID of every -- for every transaction at 14 the point of sale. Generally, this will be an adult-only event with the exception of some 15 16 children that might be coming in with family 17 members. 18 MEMBER SHORT: Well --19 INVESTIGATOR PUENTE: Go ahead.

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Chair, I have a

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Go ahead, Mr.

1 Short. 2 MR. WITT: Yes, sir. MEMBER SHORT: In the blue area --3 4 MR. WITT: Yes, sir. 5 MEMBER SHORT: -- now with the black 6 lines, the fencing is that -- what is that? kind of barrier is that? 7 8 MR. WITT: So that is, it's like bike 9 rack barrier. Bike. 10 MEMBER SHORT: Okay. 11 MR. WITT: Yes, sir. So we have that 12 around kind of the red outline that you see in 13 the -- outlining the --14 Okay. MEMBER SHORT: 15 -- total piece of the green MR. WITT: 16 grass. We are also planning to put that 17 specifically around this tent, so that only 18 people that are allowed in that catered event are 19 allowed in the entry/exit point, which will be the red diamond there. 20 21 MEMBER SHORT: Okay. So how many 22 exits and egress do you have within the red

	lines? If something were to go sour, I mean.
2	MR. WITT: So at this point, we would
3	have one entry/exit. It is a tent and we would
4	remove the barrier, so that you could exit at all
5	sides of the tented area. The blue tent.
6	MEMBER SHORT: But the red area is
7	where the bike
8	MR. WITT: So the red area would be
9	the entry/exit point that we have identified.
10	MEMBER SHORT: No. The red, the long
11	lines.
12	MR. WITT: Oh, the long red lines.
13	MEMBER SHORT: Yeah.
14	MR. WITT: Yes, sir, that's also
15	barrier that could be removed. The event will be
16	happening inside the black barrier that is listed
17	on there. So we could move those barriers and
18	then anything along the red barriers as well.
19	MEMBER SHORT: Okay. So the bike
20	racks would just fold over if somebody needed to
21	get out in a hurry?
22	MR. WITT: Can you repeat that?

1	MEMBER SHORT: The bike racks would
2	fold over easily so somebody could get out of
3	there if they had to get out in a hurry?
4	MR. WITT: Yes, sir.
5	MEMBER SHORT: Okay. Have you seen
6	that, Mr
7	INVESTIGATOR PUENTE: Yes, I believe
8	I took some photographs of them actually. You
9	actually might have a copy of them.
10	MEMBER SHORT: Okay. Are you
11	satisfied, Mr. Puente?
12	INVESTIGATOR PUENTE: Yes, they are
13	easy. You can easily
14	MEMBER SHORT: Okay. Good. Okay.
15	I'm fine.
16	INVESTIGATOR PUENTE: take them
17	down.
18	MEMBER SHORT: Thank you, Mr. Chair.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You're welcome.
20	MEMBER SHORT: Thank you.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do you have any
22	other questions, Mr. Puente? Any other questions

1	by any Board Members?
2	I believe that the Board has signed-
3	off on this event, but it's the Board hasn't
4	signed-off. I don't have the original in front
5	of me, but I believe that we have signed-off on
6	this event before.
7	But if we have not, I then make a
8	motion that we approve this request.
9	MEMBER SHORT: Second.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
11	seconded the motion.
12	All those in favor say aye.
13	ALL: Aye.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
15	The matter passes 5-0-0.
16	But I believe that the Board has
17	approved this event. So if you haven't picked up
18	the license, you can actually go pick it up today
19	for that event.
20	MR. WITT: Great. Thank you so much.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
22	MR. WITT: Appreciate your time.
