ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF NEW APPLICATION

The Application filed by 1411 K Concepts Corporation, t/a Lima Twist (Applicant), for a new Retailer's Class CN License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on February 28, 2022, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On March 2, 2022, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. *See* Board Order 2022-082.

On March 10, 2022, Masoud Aboghaddareh, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement. Mr. Aboghaddareh explained that he did not appear at the Roll Call Hearing due to scheduling conflicts and miscommunication about whether he needed to attend. Mr. Aboghaddareh seeks the reinstatement of the Application so the Application and the Settlement Agreement can be approved by the Board.

In addition, the ANC 2F submitted correspondence, dated March 9, 2022, supporting the reinstatement of the Application. The ANC also indicated that the ANC and the Applicant have agreed to a Settlement Agreement.

Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that the Applicant's request constitutes good cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

ORDER

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 16th day of March 2022, **REINSTATE** the Application filed by 1411 K Concepts Corporation, t/a Lima Twist, for a New Retailer's Class CN License.
